

Junior Freshman Biology (BY1101) Tutorials.

Small group tutorials for BY1101 (JF Biology) will begin in Week 8, starting on **Monday, 17 October at 09:00**. There will be 12 sessions per week, each catering for approximately 35-50 students.

For the first few weeks all sessions will cover the same basis material (study skills, use of the recommended text book and other support material, exam preparation, etc.), so students should attend only one session per week. Thereafter, depending on demand, different sessions may be run for students without Leaving Cert Biology, or on separate topics. Further details will be announced later in the semester.

Tutorial sessions are timetabled to avoid clashes with TR071 Biology, Mathematics and Chemistry lectures, so every student should be free to attend a number of different sessions (see detailed timetable, below). Because of limited capacity in the venues, students should attempt to attend the first session in the week for which they are free, and if numbers are too great for the venue, leave and return for a later session. Attendance will be recorded. If there are still problems with numbers and capacity after the second week, we will have to assign students to sessions, but for the moment we will operate on a 'first come, first served' basis.

Three of the sessions (Monday at 09:00 and 15:00 and Wednesday at 14:00) are clashed with Geography lectures, and will especially suit students taking the Biology/Chemistry/Mathematics combination. A further three (Tuesday at 15:00 and two sessions on Wednesday at 17:00) clash with Physics lectures, and will especially suit students taking the Biology/Mathematics/Geography combination. There are no lecture clashes of any kind with the three sessions on Tuesday at 13:00 (two sessions) and Thursday at 17:00, while those of Friday, while clashing with Biology and/or Chemistry Labs, are especially suited for students with Labs in either the afternoon or morning and who are free for the remainder of the day.

The venues in use for the tutorial sessions are as follows:

- Museum 4 and the GLT (Geography Lecture Theatre) are in the Museum Building – Museum 4 on the ground floor in the far right hand corner, and GLT on the first floor above the entrance.
- LTEE1, LTEE2 and LTEE3 are in the basement of the East End (Science) Building, beneath the Chemistry and BIOLABS – LTEE3 is immediately to the left at the bottom of the stairs, LTEE2 is immediately to the right and LTEE1 is beyond LTEE2 at the end of the corridor.
- Salmon1 and Synge2 are on the ground floor of the Hamilton Building, beneath the MacNeil3 lecture theatre.
