| Module Content   | Every object has stories —shaped by human uses— to tell. This module explores how visual and material culture offers a distinctive window for understanding the past choosing specific artefacts from the ancient Mediterranean, reconstructing their 'biographies' and using them as a prism for thinking about wider social issues. Using both iconic and lesser-known objects, the module focuses on themes such as image and text; religion, power and ideology; warfare; funerary rituals; daily life and its fictions; gender and sexuality.  |  |  |  |  |
