### Assessment Details

**Details** This module is assessed by means of weekly continuous assessment (50%) and end-of-year examinations (50%).

Continuous assessments 50%:

- Weekly assignments in translation from Russian to English: 10%
- -15 best weekly assessments for Russian language structure: 10%;
- -First semester: *Referat* (approximately 1000 words in Russian) based on one selected primary source + oral presentation:10%
- Second semester: Referat (3000 words in Russian) +20 minutes oral presentation: 20%

3-hour written examinations: 50%
