This module is assessed by means of weekly continuous assessment (50%) and end-of-year examinations (50%).

Continuous assessments **50%** :

- Weekly assignments in translation from Russian to English: 10%

-15 best weekly assessments for Russian language structure: 10%;

-First semester: *Referat* (approximately 1000 words in Russian) based on one selected primary source + oral presentation:10%

- Second semester: *Referat* (3000 words in Russian) +20 minutes oral presentation: 20%

3-hour written examinations: **50%**

a) Translation (Russian-English)

Students are required to pass the written language paper (this is a non-compensatable component) and to pass the overall aggregate of all components.
