

COMMON ROOM HOUSE RULES

Admittance to the Common Room is restricted to members and their guests. Members may not normally introduce more than three guests at any one time, and members may not introduce the same guest continually. Exceptions to these rules may be granted by the Honorary Secretary. It is particularly important for legal reasons that any guest who has a drink in the bar should be signed in. There is a Visitors Book in the bar.

No person under the age of 18 years shall be admitted, and no undergraduate students, without the approval of the Honorary Secretary.

The use of the Large Common Room for receptions and entertainments, other than those arranged or sanctioned by the committee shall not be permitted. Such functions may be held in the New Common Room, subject to approval by the Honorary Secretary.

Food may be purchased and consumed only in designated areas (at present only the bar), but not elsewhere on the premises. Exceptions to this rule may be granted for approved functions.

The premises may not be used for academic, administrative or business meetings, other than those sanctioned by the Committee.

Cellular or other mobile phones may not be used on the premises. The Common Room telephone is for internal College use only and may not be used for business purposes.

Reasonable standards of conduct and dress are expected (- sports-wear is not normally acceptable -) and members who do not conform may be asked to leave the premises.

Smoking is not permitted in any area of the Common Room.

Newspapers and magazines must not be removed from the premises except by those members with a Second Readings option.

The Common Room Club is a licenced club and is subject to the usual rules regarding the sale and consumption of alcoholic liquor. In addition to drinks from the bar and the decanters in the Large Common Room, members may order wine from the Cellar; the wine list and other forms are available in the foyer; orders will be collected by the bar steward at midday, and wines may be collected from the bar after the lunch period. Members may also order wine for consumption with their lunch in the Upper Lunch Room, or on Commons.
