

## International Committee Terms of Reference

The International Committee is a sub-committee of Council and reports directly to Council on matters relating to the international affairs of the University.

The terms of reference of the International Committee are to:

1. Oversee the implementation of College's international strategic objectives as defined in the Strategic Plan 2008-2012;
2. Develop a five-year international business plan with specific qualitative and quantitative targets to meet the objectives of the Strategic Plan;
3. Monitor the implementation of objectives and achievement of international policy and student enrolment targets;
4. Review the business plan annually and revise if necessary;
5. Review policy and provide strategic advice on international matters to Council and Board;
6. Monitor developments and oversee the maintenance of a central register in respect of international relationships, including research contracts, institutional exchanges, and academic cooperation.
7. Receive reports, as required, from the Director of International Affairs.
