

Meet and Greet Service

The International Office and Students' Union are working together to offer students the opportunity to be met at Dublin Airport by a Trinity College student who will help them find their way into the city. There is no cost to the student for this service other than buying their own ticket for travel into the city centre.

Students will be met at the airport in the arrivals hall (after immigration and baggage collection) by a current Trinity student who will be wearing a bright yellow "Meet and Greet" t-shirt. Students will be able to avail of discounted fares on the "Aircoach" service into the city centre on production of a letter or email from Trinity College confirming they are a student (non-EU students will require this paperwork for immigration so keep it to hand). The fare will be €6.00 for a single ticket or €10.00 for a return ticket which can be used at any time in the future.

The coach stops outside Trinity College and from there you will be shown the Students' Union main office where there will be students who can help you find your accommodation and answer any questions you may have.

Incoming students should email meetandgreet@tcdsu.org if they would like to be met at the airport. All emails will be responded to confirming whether or not it is possible to meet you at your specific arrival time. The sooner you email meetandgreet@tcdsu.org, the greater the chance the service will be able to accommodate you.
