Early English Language

Dr Alice Jorgensen and Dr Helen Conrad-O'Briain

This course lays the linguistic foundations for the course Beginnings of English Poetry, especially for the study of Old English texts. It begins with a review of traditional grammar as applied to modern English. The bulk of the course then focuses on Old English language, using a series of simple prose readings. We finish by looking briefly at the transition to Middle English. Teaching is through lectures and through twice-weekly classes that run throughout the semester (starting in the second week of term).

Tip: ISBN (International Standard Book Number) always refers to a book

Other easy ways to identify a book are if a publisher is included or an edition

Search for this book under title, author, ISBN, or combined author/title

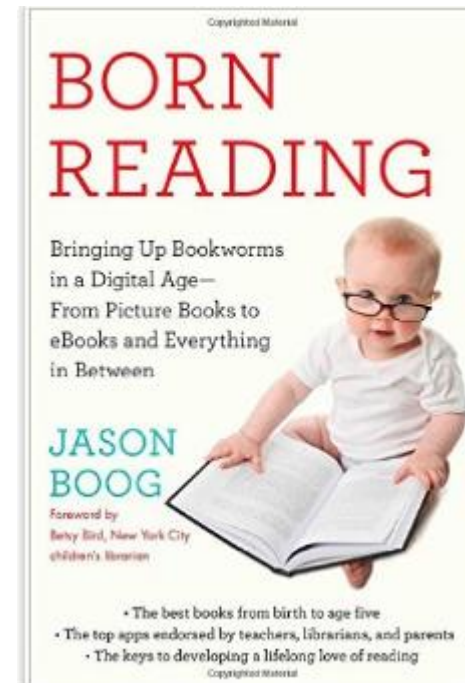
