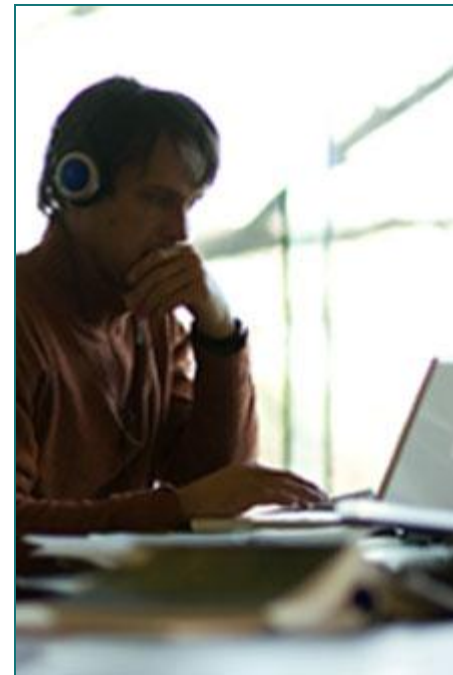

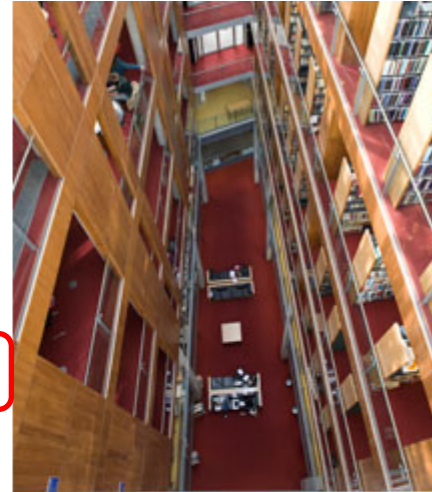

## Connecting to Resources Off Campus

There are various ways to access licensed electronic resources remotely.

### Stella Search

1. Go to [Stella Search](#)
2. Carry out an author, title or keyword search
3. From the search results screen select the electronic resource record
4. Click on the record and select "TCD-affiliated users may click here for access".
5. When presented with the login page enter College username and [network login password](#) to access the e-journal, e-book or database



### Library Website

1. Go to the [Databases and E-books](#) page, the [Journal Titles](#) page, or the [Subject Guides](#) page
2. Select the resource from the alphabetical listings or carry out a journal title search
3. From the results screen select the electronic resource record
4. Click on the record and select "TCD-affiliated users may click here for access".
5. When presented with the login page enter College username and [network login password](#) to access the e-journal, e-book or database



# What are Databases?

- Large amounts of indexed, organised and searchable data
- Offering high levels of functionality
- Which make it possible to save, bookmark, download, print and email data



# What else?

Databases can be collections or websites determined by:

- publishing format: E-journal collections, E-book collections, data sets, film or a combination of all formats
- type of content: Full text material, Abstracting and indexing services, Bibliographic lists, or a combination of all
- Subject: Science, Nursing, Business, Language, History, General

## Search Strategy Tips

**A search strategy is an information seeking plan so...**

**Determine what the keywords are**

**Identify alternative terms for these keywords (if necessary)**

**Refine the search (by date...etc.)**

**Use Boolean Searching, e.g. connect keywords with AND, OR, AND NOT and NEAR(or WITHIN)**



If you enter more than one word, **eternal love** for example, ProQuest will look for documents that contain both **eternal** and **love** in any of the document information listed above.

### Search for an exact phrase

To force ProQuest to look for your words as a phrase only, rather than finding each word separately, surround your words with quotation marks. For example, **"eternal love"** or **"life after death"**.

### Find out what databases you're searching

Information about what databases you are currently searching is displayed in the blue bar at the top of the ProQuest window.

Here's an example of how it looks:

Use the links to view the current list and [select or deselect databases](#).

### About that word list that displays beneath the search box as you type

Sometimes called 'autocomplete', this feature provides suggestions in dictionaries built from previously successful searches by all ProQuest users. The list dynamically changes as you type, to match previous searches that start with what you have entered at any point. Click any term in the list to immediately search for that term.

## Search Tips

Searching > Search Tips

These characters can come in handy when you're looking for documents that contain words that can be spelled different ways, such as **color** or **colour**, or words that begin with the same character string, such as **nursed** or **nursing**.

Character	Description	Example
?	Wildcard character - used to replace any single character, either inside or at the right end of a word. Multiple wildcards can be used to represent multiple characters.	<b>nurse?</b> Finds: nurses, nursed  <b>sm?th</b> Finds: smith and smyth  <b>ad???</b> Finds: added, adult, adopt
*	Truncation character (*) - one * for many characters. Use the truncation character at the beginning (left-hand truncation), the end (right-hand truncation), or in the middle of search terms.	<b>nurse*</b> Finds: nurse, nurses, nursed  <b>colo*r</b> Finds: colour, color

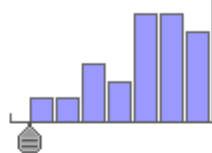

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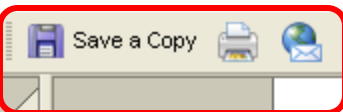

Рассматривая явление видовой парности, русские грамматические описания отмечают своеобразную асимметрию аспектуальной системы русского языка и выделяют, в частности, разряд несоотнесительных глаголов несовершенного вида (например, РГ 1980, 584, 592–595, автор раздела – Н. С. Авилова), иначе называемых *imperfectiva tantum*. Сюда же включаются многозначные глаголы, не имеющие видовой пары в каких-то из своих значений при наличии таковой в других (см. пример “отсутствия формы СВ” из известной монографии М. Я. Гловинской (1982, 40)):

- (1) *Автор изображает / изобразил Россию.*
- (2) *Картина изображает / – пожар.*

Надо полагать, что в таких случаях по определению реализовано “постоянно-непрерывное значение НСВ (глагол НСВ обозначает постоянное свойство или соотношение)” (Падучева 1996, 10):

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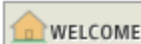

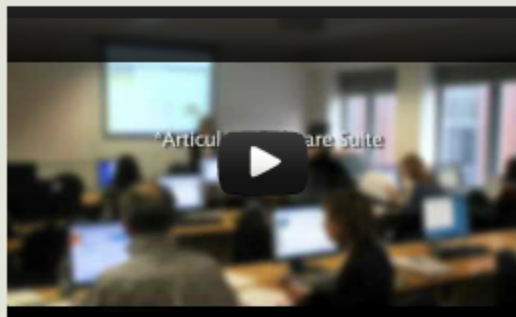

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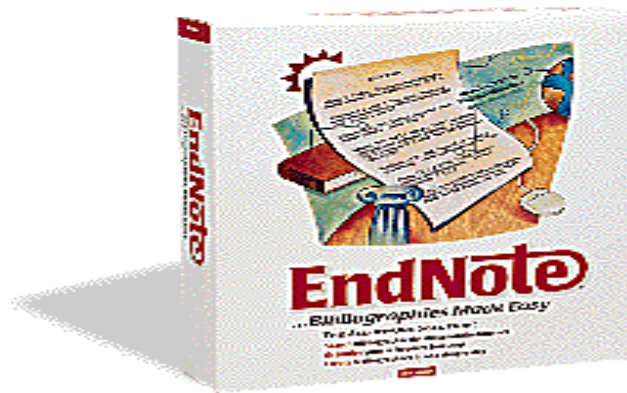
