The program consists of large and small group interactions in a comfortable environment. Presentations include role play, small group discussions and a question and answer forum.

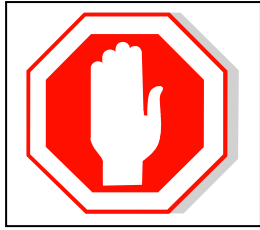
Morning and afternoon refreshments as well as a snack lunch are provided. There is a nominal charge of €30 per participant (including support workers) to cover costs.
