## **Broad Curriculum Credit Regulations**

Before submitting your application for a BC module, please check that you are eligible to apply and familiarise yourself with the credit regulations for your course.

Each undergraduate degree course is listed separately according to Faculty (with TSM courses listed separately). Information is given for each undergraduate degree course regarding credit regulations and the degree year(s) in which students are eligible to take a BC module in 2017/18. The conditions for eligibility to apply will depend on the degree course you are taking. <u>All places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis and strictly subject to timetable constraints.</u>

All applications must be made through the Broad Curriculum application and not through a student's home faculty.
