Mary O'Malley is one of Ireland's leading contemporary poets. She has published eight books of poetry, including *Valparaiso* (Carcanet, 2012), which arose from her residency on the national marine research ship, and *Playing The Octopus* (Carcanet, 2016). Her ninth collection, *Gaudent Angeli*, will be published by Carcanet in April 2019. She is also working on a memoir of childhood, and essays on place.
