The Department of Hispanic Studies will run Portuguese language and culture courses at the following levels:

Beginners: This course gives students a basic knowledge of Portuguese language, culture, and contemporary society. Students should learn to make themselves understood in everyday conversational situations and be able to read and write simple Portuguese texts.

Advanced Beginners: This course is offered to learners who have the required knowledge of Portuguese grammar and some communicative competence to build up their fluency and consolidate their knowledge of the language and culture.

Lower Intermediate: This course provides students with the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of grammatical structures, to develop vocabulary, reading, and communicative accuracy through the study of Portuguese culture.

FEE

€390 for a 22-week course. This includes course materials. This fee is non-refundable once the course has commenced. A concession rate (€280) is available to Trinity undergraduate and postgraduate students, to unemployed, and to those in receipt of a social welfare pension.
