The BCool meeting gathers each year specialists on stellar magnetic fields and their impact on exoplanets. I am delighted to announce that the 2018 edition of the Bcool meeting will be hosted by Trinity College, Dublin, Ireland, from 9 to 11 April, 2018.

The format will follow the successful model of our 6 previous meetings (Toulouse, Göttingen, St Andrews, Geneva, Vienna and Montpellier) with three days of discussion on the following topics: cool stars magnetic fields, activity, winds, star-planet interaction, spectropolarimetry, and the future of spectropolarimetric studies of cool stars at infrared wavelengths, particularly with SPIRou which will soon begin science operations at CFHT.
