Steve is working to protect local stores in **Mevagissey & Gorran** from unwanted **supermarket developments**.

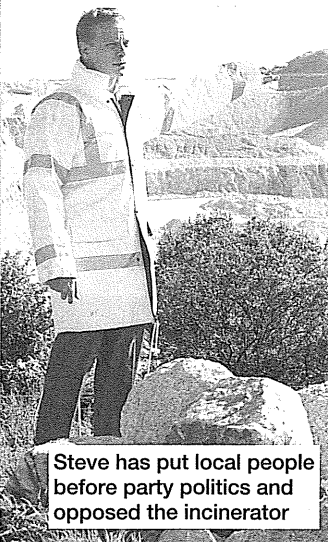
The Clay Area

Steve has put local people before party politics and opposed the incinerator

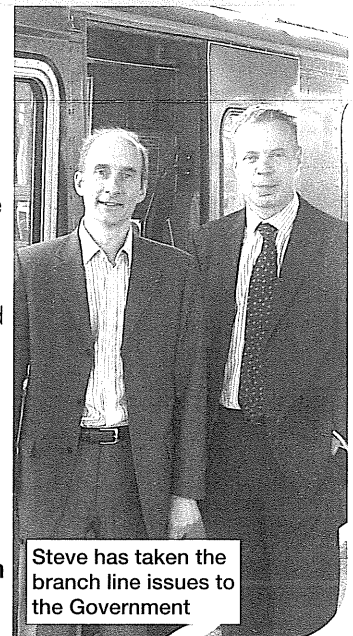
St Blazey/ Par
