

Advanced Russian Intensive Course (B2/C1 Level, 30 Hours)

This intensive course consists of 30 contact hours and is designed for students who already possess a strong command of Russian (B2 level or equivalent) and wish to refine their linguistic accuracy and stylistic range. The course integrates elements of Russian culture, providing learners with insights into everyday life, traditions, social norms, and contemporary cultural practices.

Key grammar areas include:

- Verbs of motion with prefixes (literal and metaphorical meanings)
- Participles and adverbial participles in formal and written styles
- Complex sentence structures, including concessive, conditional, and causal clauses
- Revision of case usage in abstract and idiomatic expressions

Students engage with authentic materials such as newspaper articles, opinion pieces, interviews, and short literary extracts. The course includes structured debates and advanced listening tasks.

By the end of the course, learners will be able to express complex ideas fluently and spontaneously, adapt their language to different registers and audiences, analyse and interpret texts, and produce well-structured spoken discourse with a high degree of grammatical control and stylistic awareness.

The course will run from 3 June to 25 June 2026. All learning materials will be provided by the School.
