Who the course is intended for	This course is aimed at students who have completed the course of Croatian, Upper Intermediate. Otherwise the placement test will be required.
<b>Course content</b>	
Language awareness Cultural awareness Topics & themes	Teaching will use the communicative approach. Lectures will enable students to acquire communicative, grammatical and cultural competences. Topics will be presented through contemporary authentic texts. The Advanced Intermediate level includes the <i>understanding</i> of topics (listening, writing of comments and short essays on given topic), the <i>enrichment of vocabulary</i> (phraseology, lexemes, collocations, verbs in context), <i>speaking acts</i> in different situations, learning of <i>grammar</i> (syntax, lexical exercises) and <i>orthography</i> , and the acquiring of <i>cultural competences</i> about Croatian culture (author's texts on different aspects of Croatian culture).
