The basic level includes the <i>understanding</i> of basic written and spoken texts, <i>speaking</i> (greeting, introducing, asking and giving information, describing, retelling, expressing opinions, emotions and interests, understanding and use of the rules of politeness) and <i>writing</i> of short texts (forms, postcards, messages, letters, curriculum vitae).
