Course content	
Language awareness	Course includes introduction to polish pronunciation, basic grammar and practical vocabulary necessary for fundamental communication skills. Every class work includes practicing new vocabulary and grammar as well as applying the knowledge to practical, real-life situations. The grammar material will cover as follows: consonants and vowels in Polish, conjugation of verbs, cases (Nominative, Genitive, Accusative and Instrumental), personal, possessive and demonstrative pronouns, negation, questions and word order, agreement patterns, adjectives and comparison of adjectives
Cultural awareness/ Topics and Themes	Students will learn understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs as follows: greetings, introducing oneself, friends and family, describing how one feels, describing people, things, discussing hobbies, activities, and preferences, describing daily routines, ordering food in a restaurant or café, buying food, shopping of clothes, organising a meeting, booking ataxi and ordering things, numbers, days, months, and dates; simple time expressions.
