Covid-19 Health & Safety Protocols

All users must follow the health and safety and hygiene protocols outlined below and up to date measures established by the health authorities against Covid-19.

- Any athlete attending the Trinity Boathouse confirms that they have not displayed any symptoms of COVID-19 and have not been diagnosed with a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 infection in the last 14 days. Additionally, the athlete confirms that they have not been in contact with any confirmed or suspected case, nor have they been advised to self-isolate at this time.
- Athletes must complete a Return to Activity form prior to their first training session and check in at each training session for contact tracing purposes.
- Social distancing of a minimum of 2m must be observed at all times.
- The Boathouse indoor facilities will remain closed to the athletes with the exception being the disabled toilets which will only be used if needed - the relevant member of staff must be contacted to open this facility.
- Booking times are designated to 2-hour slots. Athletes may not enter the slipway before the designated booking time and must vacate it immediately afterwards.
- All users who arrive by car, should remain in their car in the carpark until five minutes before your booking, maintaining social distancing requirements, prior to entering the Boathouse grounds at your allocated time.
- All athletes should arrive in training kit and bring your own water bottle.
- All athletes must use the provided hand sanitiser / washing station upon arrival at the Boathouse.
- Changing rooms and showers will be closed, so please factor this into your day.
- If you feel unwell with Covid-19 symptoms when in the facility you will be escorted by a member of staff to the isolation room located on the first floor of the Boathouse, while maintaining social distancing. You will apply face mask and wait there until appropriate contact is made to your GP. You should make your own way home, the way you arrived or arrange for a family member from the same household to collect you.
- Exit the facility one person at a time maintaining Social Distancing.
- Any accidents and incidents must be reported to staff immediately.
- All personal belongings must be taken home after your session.
