16th September 2021

- Access rights to support teaching and research restored to the estate for staff and students as follows:
 - Staff & PG 24/7.
 - UG access Monday to Friday 07:00 to 22:00 and Weekends 07:00 to 16:00.
- Trinity Hall JCR Freshers' Activities.
- SU Activity during Freshers' Week from 20th September.
- Non-Teaching Indoor Activities in line with easing of Government Restrictions from 6th September.
- Indoor Society Events from 20th September.
- The removal of the restriction on back-to-back bookings in study spaces for the period up to and including Reading Week starting 25th October.
- Easing of restrictions in Trinity Sport for attendance of spectators at outdoor sports matches and fully immune indoor activities from 20th September.
- Maintenance of attendance logs for contact tracing purposes no longer required for teaching activities. However, students are asked to take a photo of the seat they are sitting in at lectures.
- The re-opening of the Senior Common Room and Loos Bar (communication will issue from SCR).
