



Covid-19 Once Off Emergency Grant

The Minister for Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science has introduced a Covid-19 Once Off Emergency Allowance of €250 for SUSI and higher education students.

You are eligible for the Covid-19 Grant of €250 if you meet **ALL** the following criteria:

- Full time student
- EU Undergraduate student or EU Postgraduate student
- Ordinarily registered in Trinity at the 1st November 2020

Please note, there is no requirement to apply for the credit or contact Trinity directly.

Students will automatically receive the €250 as follows:

1. Eligible students already in receipt of fee or grant funding from Student Universal Support Ireland (SUSI) in 2020/21

- You will receive your €250 from SUSI. For further information, please refer to [SUSI website](#)
- If you have applied to SUSI and have not yet received a decision on your 2020/21 application, €250 from SUSI or a €250 credit on your Trinity student account will be applied once a decision has been made.

2. Eligible students not in receipt of SUSI

€250 will be credited to your Trinity student account before the **28th February 2021**.

- **If you owe fees on your account** – The €250 credit will be automatically allocated against these fees.
- **If you do not owe fees on your account**
 - **Continuing students** - You will receive a €250 refund, if you update your bank account details on your my.tcd.ie student portal in the section, My Financials by the **20th January 2020**. If your bank details are not updated on your student portal by the 20th January, this credit will be utilised against the next academic year (2021/22) fees
 - **Final year students** - You will receive a €250 refund, if you update your bank account details on your my.tcd.ie student portal in the section, My Financials by the **20th January 2020**.
