### Spring Commencements 2027

Invitations are typically issued 4 to 6 weeks before your ceremony via your [my.tcd.ie](https://my.tcd.ie) portal. Students with no access to their portal should attempt logging in via 'Other Users' and by selecting 'Forgot your password?' and following the on-screen instructions. The Academic Registry does not manage access to this portal and any queries regarding such should be directed to [itservicedesk@tcd.ie](mailto:itservicedesk@tcd.ie).

The ceremony lasts approximately one hour followed by refreshments in the Dining Hall. Ceremonies are often subject to delays, and it is recommended you leave at least two hours (or up to three) from your ceremony start time to any reservation to ensure you are not late to your booking.

Doctoral and Research candidates are required to submit an [Application/ Notice of Candidature](#) in order to receive an invitation. Candidates deferring from previous academic years must also complete an Application/ Notice of Candidature. **Application deadline is February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2027.**
