# Sample Wording

## Residents of the Republic of Ireland

Thank you for considering making a gift to Trinity College Dublin (“TCD”), in your will.

Please note all sample wording is for information purposes only and should not be relied upon as legal advice. In all cases, we recommend that you consult your solicitor who will be able to advise you in light of your own particular circumstances.

To ensure that a gift can be efficiently transferred to the University, the following are sample formats for inclusion in a will:

### A Financial Gift

“I give the sum of € \_\_\_\_\_ (in figures and words) to Trinity College Dublin (Charity Number CHY11) to be used for the general charitable purposes of TCD. I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer of Trinity College shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executor(s)”.

### A Gift of an Asset

### A Residual Gift

“I give the whole (or a \_\_\_\_\_ % share) of the residue of my estate to Trinity College Dublin (Charity Number CHY11) to be used for the general charitable purposes of TCD. I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer of Trinity College shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executor(s)”.

### Reversionary Legacy

The wording above should be adapted to suit your particular needs and wishes.

**If you wish to make a gift to a specific area or School in Trinity College, please amend the clause accordingly. We recommend that you contact us, in confidence, to discuss your intentions and to ensure that we understand and can act on your wishes.**

Trinity College Dublin has charitable status and thus your legacy will be exempt from inheritance tax.
