

Trinity Joint Honors Programme

GENERAL REGULATIONS¹

1 Students entering the Trinity joint honors programme will have the opportunity to exit with a joint honors degree, or a major with minor degree, or a single honors degree, depending on the number of credits that they study in each subject.

2 The subjects available in the Trinity joint honors programme are: ancient history and archaeology, classical civilisation, classical languages, drama studies, economics, English literature, film studies, French, geography, German, history, history of art and architecture, Irish, Italian, mathematics, Middle Eastern, Jewish and Islamic civilisations, music, philosophy, religion, Russian, sociology, and Spanish. Details on subject content and assessment can be found in the relevant departmental handbook.
