The GDPR imposes restrictions on the transfer of personal data to third countries or international organisations located outside of the European Economic Area ('EEA') and UK.	The GDPR imposes restrictions on the transfer of personal data to third countries or international organisations located outside of the European Economic Area ('EEA') and UK. These restrictions are in place to ensure that the level of protection and accountability afforded by the GDPR is not undermined. 'EEA' means the members of the European Union's internal market and Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway. Note: the UK includes Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.
