Deadline: 5pm on Monday 20th March 2017

An email will be sent to all applicants to notify them of the status of their application after the shortlisting process has taken place.

Emails, including junk mail folders, should be checked regularly after the deadline.

Interview date: Tuesday 16th May 2017

Candidates should present to the 3rd Floor of the Dublin Dental Hospital 10 minutes before their allotted time for an interview and a practical assessment in which they will be asked to perform some basic orthodontic tasks.

They are then free to leave DDUH.

In the afternoon the trainer interviews will take place.

These will last approximately 15 minutes per candidate.

After the Interview and Practical Assessment:

An email will be sent to all interviewees to notify them of the outcome shortly afterwards. Practice visits for successful candidates will be timetabled during May and June.

Please note that an invitation to interview does **NOT** imply that a workplace visitation will take place.

An email will be sent to all successful candidates at a later date, which will include details of bench fees, blood tests, Garda clearance, etc.
