At that meeting, it was asked if the Irish Language Award would take place for this academic year. The question was discussed, and it was decided that it would not appropriate to hold them currently.

Official Languages Act and the Third Language Scheme</p> <p>It was confirmed that contact was made with the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht to request a deadline extension for the compilation of a new Language Scheme. A consultation process will take place in the drafting of the Scheme and discussion is to take place on bringing together committee for this work.</p>

<p>Scéim Cónaithe 2020/21</p> <p>Tá an próiseas iarratais do Scéim Cónaithe 2020/21 oscailte do mhic léinn reatha. Tá sé i gceist na hagallaimh a réachtáil ar Microsoft Teams agus táthar ag obair le Seirbhísí TF na hollscoile faoi láthair chun teacht ar an gcur chuige is fearr don phróiseas seo.</p> <p>Ní dhéanfar fógraíocht ar Scéim na chéad bhliana go fóill go dtí go mbeidh níos mó eolais ar fáil maidir leis an Ardteistiméireacht agus na dátaí agus an cur chuige a bheidh i gceist leis an mbliain acadúil nua. Tá go leor éiginnteachta ann faoi láthair agus mar sin, tá sé deacair pleanáil chun cinn a dhéanamh don Scéim.</p>	<p>2020/21 Residency Scheme</p> <p>The application process for the 2020/21 Residency Scheme is open for current students. It is intended to hold the interviews on Microsoft Teams and work is underway with the university's IT Services to decide on the best approach for this process.</p> <p>The Residency Scheme for first year students will not be advertised until further information is available on the Leaving Certificate and the dates and approach that will be required in the new academic year. There is currently a lot of uncertainty surrounding these matters and therefore, it is difficult to plan ahead for the Scheme.</p>
<p>Ranganna Gaeilge</p> <p>Tá dháráeg cláraithe do na ranganna ar líne agus rachaidh an síntíús sin in éag faoi dheireadh mhí na Bealtaine.</p> <p>Caithfear conradh nua a chur i bhfeidhm do sholáthar na ranganna sa bhliain acadúil nua. Ag an bpóinte seo, d'fhéadfadh go mbeadh gá na ranganna go léir a chur ar líne do Théarma na Féile Michíl. D'fhéadfadh sé seo an rogha soláthraithe a laghdú mar go gcaithfeadh go mbeadh cumas acu ranganna beo ar líne a chur ar fáil. Tá sé deacair a thuar ag an bpóinte seo cén leibhéal spéise a bheidh sna cúrsáí má bhíonn siad go hiomlán ar líne.</p> <p>Ciorcal Comhrá</p> <p>Cuireadh an ciorcal comhrá ar siúl ar Zoom an tseachtaí seo caite ar bhonn píolótach, agus tugadh cuireadh do dhaoine a fhreastalaíonn air de ghnáth agus do mhic léinn agus do bhaill foirne áirithe a bheith páirteach ann. Tá plé ar bun maidir</p>	<p>Irish Language Classes</p> <p>There are twelve learners registered for the online classes and this subscription will expire at the end of May.</p> <p>A new supplier contract will be required in the new academic year. At this point, it may be necessary to hold all classes online for Michaelmas Term. This may reduce the choice of suppliers available as they will need to be capable of providing live online classes. It is currently difficult to estimate how much interest there will be in the courses if they are fully online.</p> <p>Conversation Circle</p> <p>The conversation circle was held online on a pilot basis last week and those who regularly attend, and a number of staff and students were invited to take part. Over 20 people took part online for one hour. There was a significant amount of interest in the event and it is intended to continue on a trial basis.</p> <p>Induction for new staff</p> <p>The new staff induction has moved online with the programme greatly reduced as it only lasts for two hours. There is currently no opportunity to present on Irish language matters. It is currently being evaluated how information on Irish and other areas can be shared in a different way online.</p>

Níl deontais na Scéime Cónaithe (c. €15,000) do Théarma na Féile Bríde san áireamh sa chaiteachas sin. Tá sé tuartha go bhféadfaí suas le €110,000 a chaitheamh faoi dheireadh na bliana agus is buiséad €106,200 atá ceadaithe, mar sin, d'fhéadfadh go mbeadh easnamh i gceist.</p>	<p>Financial Report</p> <p>A financial report for the period October 2019 – March 2020 was provided.</p> <p>€59,506.92 has been spent on pay and non-pay items to date. The Residency Scheme grant payments (approx. €15,000) for Hilary Term are not included in this expenditure. It is forecast that expenditure could reach up to €110,000 by year-end which would lead to a deficit with a budget of €106,200.00 allowed.</p>

Tuairisc an Chumainn Ghaelaigh</p> <p>Rinne an Reachtaile nuathofa cur síos ar obair reatha an Chumainn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Beartaíodh ar an toghchán don choiste nua a réachtáil ar líne thar aon lá déag (d'aon phost déag). Mhair an toghchán do gach post lá amháin agus rinneadh vótáil ar líne. Cuireadh bronnadh Ghraim Ghór na nGael ar athló, mar sin, níor fógraíodh na buaiteoirí go fóill. Beidh ar an gCumann cur chuige difriúil a bheith acu an bliain seo chugainn má bhíonn ranganna agus imeachtaí le bheith ar líne. Caithfear a bheith an-ghníomhach ar na meáin shóisialta agus beidh sé níos dúshlánaí baill nua a mhealladh. Cuirfidh sé seo isteach ar chúrsaí airgeadais an Chumainn. An Cumann Gaelach Report</p> <p>The newly elected Auditor reported on the society's current work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elections were held online over the course of eleven days (for eleven posts) to assign a new committee. The election for each post lasted one day and voting took place online. The Glór na nGael awards have been postponed and therefore the winners have yet to be announced. The society are preparing for a different approach next year if classes and activities move online. It is acknowledged that they will need to be very active on social media and that it will be more challenging to attract new members, and this will affect the society's finances. Preparation is underway for the possibility of first year students' starting dates being later than usual. This will require a delay of activities such as the "Maidens" debating competition, EGM election, musical auditions, etc. The society is awaiting further information from the CSC on Fresher's Week.
