Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla & an Ceathrú Scéim Teanga Cuireadh in iúl go raibh comhfhreagras faighte ón An Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán maidir leis an gceathrú scéim teanga. Ní cheadófar aon scéimeanna teanga nua go hoifigiúil os rud é go bhfuil Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla (Leasú), 2021 tagtha i bhfeidhm agus go mbeidh caighdeán á dtabhairt isteach faoi sin a thógfaidh áit na scéimeanna teanga. Beidh an tríú scéim i bhfeidhm go dtí go leagtar síos na caighdeáin. Moladh go scríobfaí chuig an Roinn chun míshástacht a chur in iúl mar gheall ar an am agus airgead atá caite le dréachtadh na scéime. Cuirfear achoimre ar phríomhphointí an Achta leasaithe ar fáil mar aguisín le miontuairiscí an chruinnithe seo.	The minutes of the meeting held on 1st April 2022 were approved. 4. Official Languages Act and the Fourth Language Scheme Correspondence has been received from the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media in relation to the fourth language scheme. No new language schemes will be officially approved as the Official languages (Amendment) Act 2021 is now effective and standards will be introduced under this which will take the place of the language schemes. The third language scheme will remain in place until the standards are set. It was suggested to write to the Department to express dissatisfaction regarding the time and money that has been spent in drafting the scheme. A summary of the amended Act's main points will be provided as an appendix with the minutes of this meeting.

Pléadh é seo le Cláraitheoir na Seomraí agus le dlíodóir an Choláiste agus soiléiríodh gur cheart, de réir na Staitiúidí, go mbeadh mac léinn scoláireacht in ann glacadh le háit ar an Scéim agus an scoláireacht a úsáid chun costas an lóistín a chlúdach. Scéim an Champais agus Scéim na Dara Bliana Tá an próiseas roghnúcháin curtha i gcrích don Scéim seo agus tá 18 mac léinn roghnaithe don bhliain acadúil 2022-23. Caitheadh an spriocdháta a shíneadh ach fuarthas thart ar 60 iarratas, ardú ó 47 anuraidh. Reáchtáladh na hagallaimh ar líne agus gabhadh buíochas leis Dr Mícheál Hoyne as a bheith ar an bpainéal agallaimh. Scéim na Chéad Bhliana Tá an próiseas iarratais fógartha don Scéim seo ina gcuirfear 12 spás ar fáil do mhic léinn céad bhliana don bhliain acadúil 2022-23. Tá sé i gceist na hagallaimh a réachtáil go luath i mí Iúil tar éis hArdteiste. Ranganna Gaeilge Fuarthas torthaí measctha ar an suirbhé a scaipeadh ar fhoghlaimeoirí ag deireadh théarma na Féile Bríde maidir leis na ranganna a bheith ar líne. Report of the Irish Language Officer The Irish Language Officer gave an account of the ongoing work of the Office. Irish Language Residency Scheme A question arose recently in relation to student Scholars and their ability to take part in the Irish Language Residency Scheme and to use the scholarship to offset accommodation costs while on the Scheme. It has happened previously that a Scholar was unable to take up a place on the Scheme while using their scholarship funds. The question was discussed with the Registrar of Chambers and the College Solicitor and it was clarified that, according to the Statutes, a Scholar student is entitled to take part in the Scheme and to use the scholarship to cover the accommodation costs. Campus & Second-Year Irish Residency Scheme The selection process for this Scheme has been completed with 18 students selected for the academic year 2022-23. The deadline was extended and approximately 60 applications were received, an increase from 47 last year. The interviews were held online and Dr Mícheál Hoyne was thanked for his time given on the interview panel. First Year Irish Residency Scheme The application process has been announced for this Scheme which will provide 12 spaces for first year students in the 2022-23 academic year. Interviews are to be held in early July after the Leaving Certificate. Irish Language Classes The survey circulated to learners at the end of Hilary Term produced mixed results in relation to classes being held online. There were 24 responses and 58% indicated that they would like classes to remain online (Vs 73% in Michaelmas

Tuairisc Airgeadais Cuireadh cuntas airgeadais don tréimhse Deireadh Fómhair 2021 go Aibreán 2022 ar fáil don Choiste. Tá €64,480.64 caite sa bhliain go dtí seo idir ábhair phá agus neamh-phá. Tá buiséad na bliana seo (€98,770.35) laghdaithe go suntasach ó bhuiséad €106,500 a bhí ar fáil in 2020-21. Cuireadh in iúl don Rannóg Seirbhísí Airgeadais ag tús na bliana go mbeadh tionscadail éagsúla nach bhféadfaí a chur i gcrích anuraidh de bharr na paidéime i gceist i mbliana. Luadh ag an am go mbeadh buiséad cosúil leis an mbliain anuraidh ar fáil. Meastar go mbeidh thart ar €6,000 breise ag teastáil chun costais na bliana a chlúdach.	Term) and 33% answered that they would like them to be on campus (Vs 23% in Michaelmas Term). If classrooms can be secured in the new academic year, it is hoped that more of them will be on-site. A new contract will be put in place with a provider for the new academic year. Translation The Provost has a policy that all emails sent to the College community are bilingual and the Irish Language Officer supports her office in providing these translations. Conversation Circle The conversation circle is currently held in the Buttery each fortnight and is online every other week. This will continue for the summer, and a return to campus fulltime will be considered after the summer. Financial Report A financial account for the period October 2021 to April 2022 was provided for the Coiste. Expenditure stands at €64,480.64 to date including pay and non-pay items. This year's budget (€98,770.35) is significantly reduced from €106,500 in 2020-21. FSD was informed at the beginning of the year that projects which could not be completed last year due to the pandemic would be done this year. It was stated at the time that a budget similar to last year would be available. It is estimated that an additional approximately €6,000 will be needed to cover the costs for the year.
