2. Ballraíocht Ghabh an Cathaoirleach buíochas leis na baill as a bheith i láthair don chruinniú lasmuigh den tréimhse acadúil. An fáth a bhí leis sin ná chun plé a dhéanamh ar an dréachtscéim teanga. Fáiltíodh roimh bhall nua, an Dr Nóirín Nic a’ Bháird, a bheidh ina hionadaí do Dhámh na hEolaíochta, na Teicneolaíochta, na hInnealtóireachta agus na Matamaitice. Tá tréimhsí áirithe ballraíochta ag teacht chun deiridh i gcás roinnt ball agus beifear ag súil iad sin a shíneadh ar feadh tréimhse trí bliana eile.	2. Membership The Chair thanked members for their attendance at the meeting outside the academic period. The reason for this was to discuss the draft language scheme. Dr Nóirín Nic a’ Bháird, the new Coiste representative for the Faculty of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics, was welcomed. Other periods of membership are coming to an end and it is hoped to extend these for a further three years.

3. Miontuairiscí Glacadh le miontuairiscí an chruinnithe ón 14 Aibreán 2021. Rinneadh tagairt do roinnt pointí atá sna miontuairiscí. Luadh go raibh litir cumtha agus le seoladh go muintir Chliona Ní Shúilleabháin. Moladh ag an gcruinniú deireanach go gcuirfí litir comhghairdis go Muireann Nic Corcráin as a bheith tofa ina Leas-Uachtarán don Ghaeilge le AMLÉ. Níl sí sin le seoladh anois mar go bhfuil glactha ag Muireann le ról difriúil lasmuigh de AMLÉ. Rinneadh teagmháil le Stiúrthóir na nAcmhainní Daonna chun í a chur ar an eolas faoin mBille Teanga nua agus an chaoi a bhféadfadh éifeacht a bheith aige ar an rannóg sin. D'éisigh an Rialtas ceannteidil leasuithe le déanaí agus tá sé i gceist go ndéanfaí teagmháil le hoifigí áirithe san ollscoil maidir leis na himpleachtaí a d'fhéadfadh a bheith ag an mBille orthu. <i>Ag an bpointe seo thug Oifigeach Gaeilge Aontas na Mac Léinn, Aislinn Ní Dhómhnaill, tuairisc don Choiste ar a cuid oibre (pointe 7 thíos). Ansin leanadh ar aghaidh le pointe 4 thíos, Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla & an Ceathrú Scéim Teanga.</i> 4. Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla & an Ceathrú Scéim Teanga Bille na dTeangacha Oifigiúla (Leasú) Cuireadh in iúl gur tháinig críoch le plé ar an mBille Teanga ag céim an Choiste le déanaí. Níor glacadh le han-chuid de leasuithe an fhreasúra ach d'fhógair an tAire Stáit, Jack Chambers, ceannteidil leasuithe dá chuid féin le déanaí, mar shampla: - Cuirfear spriocdháta leis an bhforáil go mbeidh 20% de na hearcaithe nua sa tseirbhís phoiblí inniúil sa Ghaeilge; - Beidh an síneadh fada in úsáid i gcórais TF de chuid chomhlachtaí poiblí; - Beidh ar chomhlacht poiblí 20% dá chuid fógraíochta a dhéanamh i nGaeilge agus ní mór do 5% de sin a bheith sna meáin Ghaeilge; - Beidh lógónna nua atá le húsáid ag comhlachtaí poiblí i nGaeilge nó i nGaeilge agus i mBéarla. Luadh go bhféadfadh go leor athruithe a bheith i gceist don ollscoil agus go rachfaí i dteagmháil leis na hoifigí ábhartha chun iad a chur ar an eolas e.g. Acmhainní Daonna, Seirbhísí TF, an rannóg margaíochta, srl.	3. Minutes The minutes of the meeting held on 14th April 2021 were approved. Reference was made to a number of points in the minutes. A letter has been composed and is to be sent to Cliona Ní Shúilleabháin's family. It was suggested at the last meeting that a letter of congratulations would be sent to Muireann Nic Corcráin for her election to the role of Vice-President for the Irish Language with the USI. Muireann has assumed a different role outside of the USI and the letter will not be sent. The Director of HR has been notified about the new Irish Language Bill and how it may affect the office. Revised amendments were recently issued by Government and it is intended to contact selected offices in the university regarding the possible implications of the Bill for them. <i>At this stage, the Irish Language Officer of the Union of Students, Aislinn Ní Dhómhnaill, reported to the Committee on its work (point 7 below). Point 4 below followed the Official Languages Act & Fourth Language Scheme.</i> 4. Official Languages Act and the Fourth Language Scheme Official Languages (Amendment) Bill Discussions on the Languages Bill at committee stage ended recently. Many of the opposition's amendments were not accepted but the Minister of State, Jack Chambers, recently announced his own heads of amendments, for example: - A deadline will accompany the provision that 20% of new recruits to the public service will be competent in Irish; - The use of the "síneadh fada" will be accommodated in all ICT systems operated by public bodies' - Each public body will carry out at least 20% of its annual advertising in the Irish language and 5% in the Irish language media; - New logos to be used by public bodies will be in Irish or in Irish and English. These amendments will result in changes across the university and the relevant offices will be contacted to inform them e.g. HR, IT Services, marketing, etc.
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An Scéim Teanga Rinne an tOifigeach Gaeilge achoimre ar an dréachtcháipéis den Scéim Teanga a bhí scaipthe ar bhaill an Choiste roimh ré. Rinneadh cur síos ar aon athruithe nó nuashonruithe a bhí déanta ón tríú scéim teanga agus ar na príomhghéalltanais atá leagtha amach sa scéim nua; ó chumarsáid scríofa agus foirmeacha iarratais, go córais teicneolaíochta faisnéise agus úsáid na Gaeilge ar na meáin shóisialta. Cuireadh fáilte roimh cheisteanna agus tuairimí an Choiste. Luaigh an Cathaoirleach gurb í an chéad chéim eile sa phróiseas don Scéim Teanga ná an cháipéis a sheoladh chuig an Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán le faomhadh sula gcuirfear os comhair Bhord na hollscoile í.	Irish Language Scheme The Irish Language Officer summarised the draft language scheme which had been circulated to members in advance. Changes and updates from the third language scheme were outlined as well as the main commitments given in the new scheme; from written communications and application forms to information technology systems and the use of Irish on social media. Questions and comments were welcomed from members. The Chair explained that the next step in the process is to submit the document to the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media for approval before it is sent to the College Board.
5. Tuairisc Oifigeach na Gaeilge Thug an tOifigeach Gaeilge cuntas ar imeachtaí an téarma agus ar obair leanúnach na hOifige. An Ceathrú Scéim Teanga Táthar tar éis a bheith ag obair le hoifigí agus le ranna éagsúla san ollscoil le roinnt míonna chun géalltanais nua a aontú. Cuireadh na tuairimí agus na moltaí a bailíodh ó phobal na hollscoile tríd an bpróiseas comhairliúcháin san áireamh agus iad á gcur le chéile. Tá thart ar 30 géalltanais nua éagsúil i gceist. An Scéim Cónaithe 2021/22 Tá an próiseas roghnúcháin do Scéim an Champais agus na Dara Bliana curtha i gcrích. Bhí laghdú ar líon na n-iarratas i mbliana agus tá seans ann go bhfuil baint ag an bpaindéim agus ag an éiginnteacht a bhaineann léi leis sin. Reáchtáladh na hagallaimh ar líne agus gabhtar buíochas leis an Dr Mícheál Hoyne a bhí ar an bpainéal agallaimh. Cuireadh beagnach 40 mac léinn faoi agallamh do 18 spás agus tá na spásanna sin ofráilte anois do na mic léinn a roghnaíodh. Tá an próiseas roghnúcháin do Scéim na Chéad Bhliana ag teacht chun críche. Bhí laghdú ar líon na n-iarratas chomh maith i gcomparáid le blianta roimhe seo. Reáchtáladh na hagallaimh ar líne an tseachtain seo caite agus gabhtar buíochas leis an Dr Dónall Mac Dónaill a bhí ar an bpainéal agallaimh. Cuireadh 25 mac léinn faoi agallamh do 12 spás. Déanfar teagmháil leis na daltaí roghnaithe an tseachtain seo chun na spásanna a ofráil dóibh. Ranganna Gaeilge Scaipeadh suirbhé aiseolais ar na foghlaimeoirí ag deireadh na gcúrsaí agus fuarthas 40 freagra. Chuir 49% in iúl gurbh fhearr leo freastal ar ranganna ar líne an bhliain seo chugainn Vs 38% a chur in iúl gurbh fhearr leo freastal ar ranganna ar an gcampus má cheadaíonn na srianta a leithéid.	5. Report of the Irish Language Officer The Irish Language Officer gave an account of the events of the term and the ongoing work of the Office. Fourth Irish Language Scheme Work has been carried out over recent months on agreeing new commitments with various College offices and departments. The views and suggestions compiled from the College community in the consultation process have been taken into account in the approximately 30 new commitments. Irish Language Residency Scheme 2021/22 The selection process for the Campus & Second Year Residency Scheme has been completed. The number of applications decreased this year and it's likely that the pandemic and the uncertainty associated with it affected this. Online interviews were conducted and Dr Mícheál Hoyne was thanked for his time on the interview panel. Nearly 40 students were interviewed for 18 spaces and those spaces have now been offered to the selected students. The selection process for the First Year Residency Scheme is coming to an end. The number of applications also decreased compared with recent years. Online interviews were conducted last week, and Dr Dónall Mac Dónaill was thanked for his time on the interview panel. 25 students were interviewed for 12 spaces. The selected students will be contacted this week to offer them the spaces. Irish Language Classes A feedback survey was distributed to learners at the end of the courses and 40 replies were received. 49% of respondents indicated that they would prefer to attend online classes next year Vs 38% who would prefer to attend classes on-campus if restrictions permit.

Ciorcal Comhrá Táthar ag leanúint ar aghaidh leis an gciorcal comhrá seachtainiúil ar líne don samhradh. Braithfidh sé ar na srianta a bheidh i bhfeidhm níos déanaí sa bhliain an mbeifí in ann teacht le chéile ar an gcampas nó lasmuigh. Tangent, Trinity's Ideas Workspace Táthar ag comhoibriú le Tangent agus le hÚdarás na Gaeltachta chun deiseanna taithí oibre a chur ar fáil do mhic léinn na hollscoile sa Ghaeltacht. Cuireadh tús le clár píolótach an samhradh seo inar ofráladh trí phost; dhá phost in gteiceanna an Údaráis sna Forbracha agus i nGaoth Dobhair a bhfuil Gaeilge ag teastáil dóibh, agus post amháin le Randox Teoranta i nDún na nGall. Táthar ag súil go mbeifear in ann forbairt a dhéanamh ar na deiseanna seo amach anseo. TEG Rinne duine amháin scrúdú TEG i mbliana. Rinneadh an scrúdú A2 iomlán (lánchreidiúint) agus cuirfear deontas €80 ar fáil i dtreo costais €120. Tuairisc Airgeadais Cuireadh cuntas airgeadais don tréimhse Deireadh Fómhair 2020 go Bealtaine 2021 (8 mí) ar fáil. Bhí caiteachas €81,594.22 idir ábhair phá agus neamh-phá i gceist as buiséad de €106,500.00. Measadh go mbeifear in ann cloí leis an mbuiséad go deireadh na bliana ach luadh arís go bhfuil suas le thart ar €6,000 nár caitheadh ar thionscadail áirithe de bharr shrianta na paindéime.	A new contract will need to be put in place for the next year's class provider. Three companies will be asked to provide quotations. Michaelmas term classes are likely to be online again this year and Hilary Term classes will depend on whether restrictions are in place at the beginning of 2022. Conversation Circle The weekly conversation circle is continuing online for the summer. It will depend on the restrictions that will apply later in the year whether the group can come together on campus or outside. Tangent, Trinity's Ideas Workspace The Irish Language Officer is working with Tangent and Údarás na Gaeltachta to provide work experience opportunities for students in the Gaeltacht. A pilot programme was launched this summer which offered three jobs; two posts in Údarás na Gaeltachta gteics in Na Forbracha and Gaoth Dobhair with an Irish language requirement, and a job with Randox in Donegal. It is hoped that these opportunities can be developed further in the future. TEG One person completed a TEG exam this year. The full examination (full certification) was undertaken at A2 level and €80 will be provided towards a cost of €120. Financial Report A financial account for the period October 2020 to May 2021 (8 months) was provided. Expenditure stands at €81,594.22 between pay and non-pay items, from a budget of €106,500.00. It is estimated that it will be possible to stay within budget until the end of the year but it was stated again that up to approximately €6,000 was not spent on certain projects due to pandemic restrictions.
6. An Cumann Gaelach Report The Auditor reported on the society's work since the last meeting: - A new committee has been elected and details are provided on the society's website. - The new officers have been trained and planning and preparation have commenced for the new academic year. - The society's officers were interviewed for the competition of third-level Irish language societies run by Glór na nGael. The winners were announced live on Raidió na Gaeltachta's show, Bladhaire, in May where An Cumann Gaelach was named in first place for the prize of €3,000. The former Auditor,

Ciara Ní Mhurchú. Tréaslaíodh leis an gCumann agus le hOifigeach Gaeilge AML as na gradaim a bhain siad amach i mbliain thar a bheith dúshlánach, is iad sin, an chéad áit i nGradaim Ghlór na nGael agus Bonn Óir na Gaeilge ó AMLÉ.	Ciara Ní Mhurchú, was interviewed. An article featured on Tuairisc.ie and can be read here. - The society has contacted the Disability Service for advice on how to make the society more open and accessible to students, with the aim of building on the work of the ‘Access to Irish for All’ campaign. - A committee meeting will be held at the end of the summer when more information on restrictions will be available from College and the CSC. It is hoped it will be possible for events to take place on campus again. The society and SU Officer were congratulated for the awards they received in a very challenging year, namely, first place in the Glór na nGael awards and the USI’s Gold Medal for Irish.

Cuirfear fochoiste le chéile sa bhliain acadúil nua. - Leanfaidh Coiste Gaeilge Aontas na Mac Léinn, a cuireadh ar bun i mbliana, ar aghaidh lena chuid oibre sa bhliain acadúil nua. - Tá scéim nua meantóireachta agus aitheantais curtha ar bun in áit scéim Bhonn na Gaeilge. Is comhpháirtíocht idir Chonradh na Gaeilge agus AMLÉ í agus tá an tOifigeach Gaeilge ag glacadh páirte ann ar son AML Choláiste na Tríonóide. Roghnaítear meantóir do gach mac léinn agus cuirfidh siad comhairle agus cúnamh ar fáil dóibh i rith na bliana. Students’ Union Report The SU Irish Language Officer gave an account of the work carried out over the course of the term. - The SU was awarded a gold medal by the USI <i>Bonn na Gaeilge</i> scheme for its efforts to use and promote the Irish language. - The dates for the Éigse na Tríonóide festival have been set for 7-11th February 2022. A sub-committee will be established in the new academic year. - The SU’s Irish Language Committee which was set up this year will continue its work in the new academic year. - A new mentoring and recognition scheme has been established to replace the <i>Bonn na Gaeilge</i> scheme. It is a partnership between Conradh na Gaeilge and the USI, and the SU Irish Language Officer will be participating on behalf of TCDSU. A mentor is selected for each student and will provide advice and assistance to them throughout the year. Colm Ó Néill has been designated as mentor for Trinity. - It is intended to discuss with the SU Communication Officer how to improve accessibility regarding the Union’s communications, for example, the addition of Irish language recordings and vocabulary to their weekly emails.
