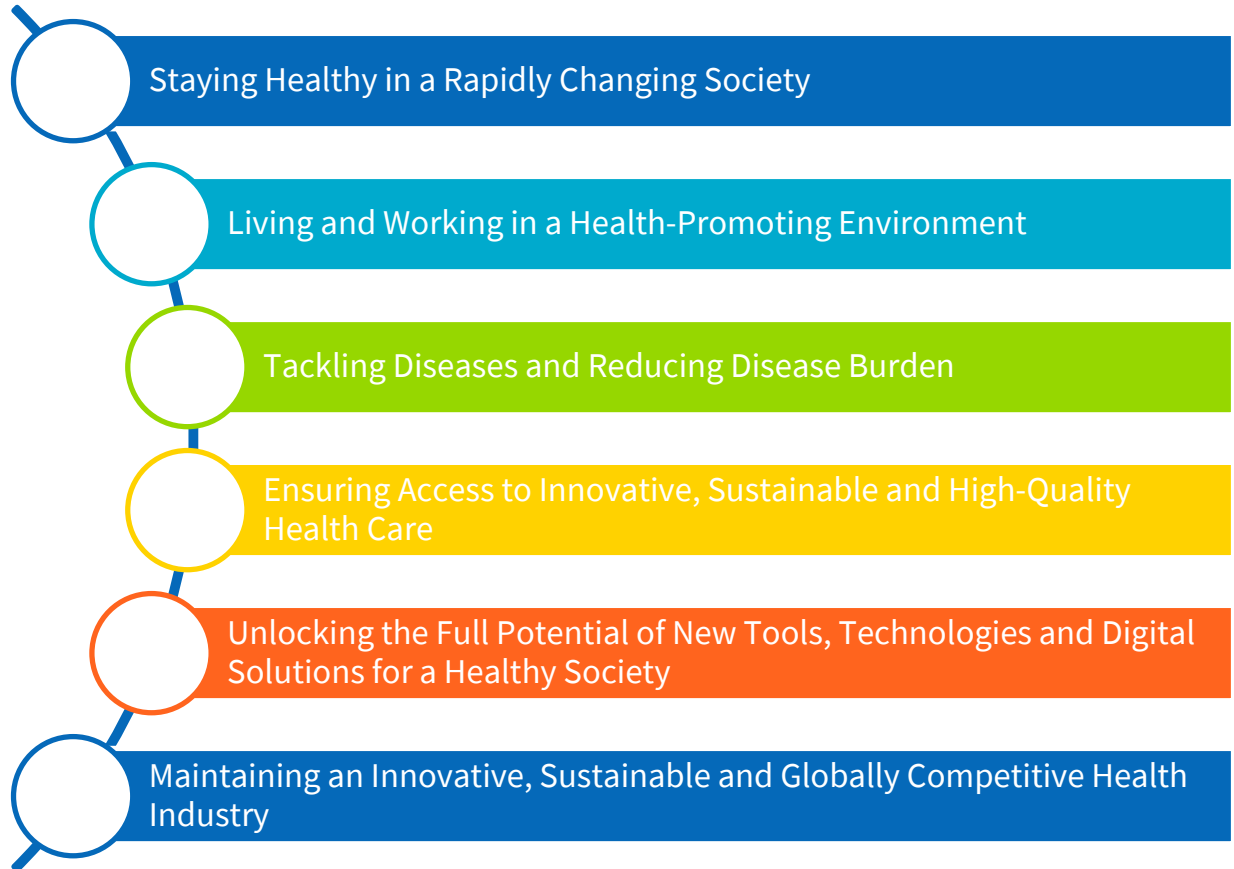

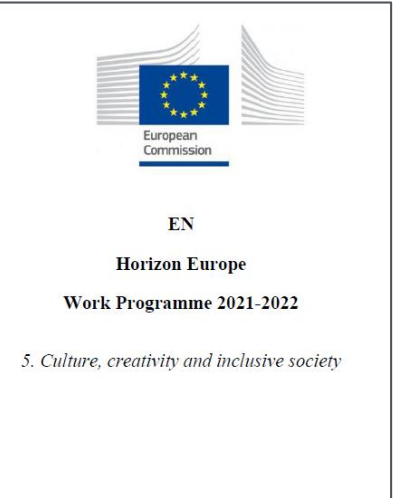

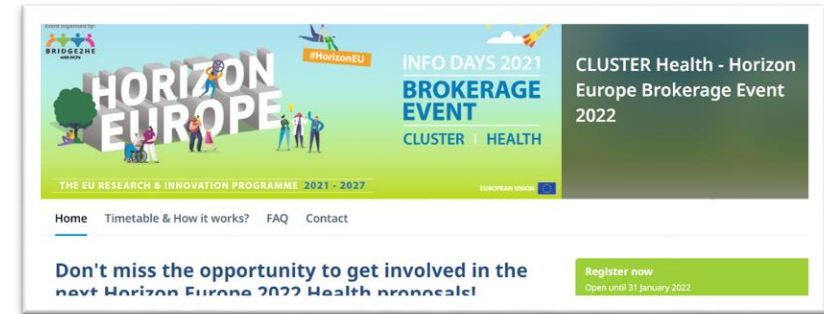

Enterprise Ireland Coordinator Support Grant

- **Value:** €12,500 (inc. VAT)
- **Deadline:** 10 weeks before call close date (apply as soon as plans are confirmed for maximum benefit)
- **Eligible costs:**
 - Research Assistant (up to €8,000)
 - Replacement teaching costs
 - Travel costs (Europe, up to €2,000)
 - Consultancy (up to €4,000) – graphic design, proposal review



New RDO Structured Supports For Horizon Europe Coordinators



- Share targeted funding opportunities and help identify the right call topic
- Guidance on the application process

- Analyse the call text and the fit of your concept to the call topic
- Logical Framework Analysis workshops

- Support application to Enterprise Ireland
- Introduction to the National Contact Points

- Stakeholder mapping exercises (workshops/meetings)
- Impact canvas workshops

- Sprint writing workshops
- Budget templates, drafting and reviews
- In-depth proposal reviews
