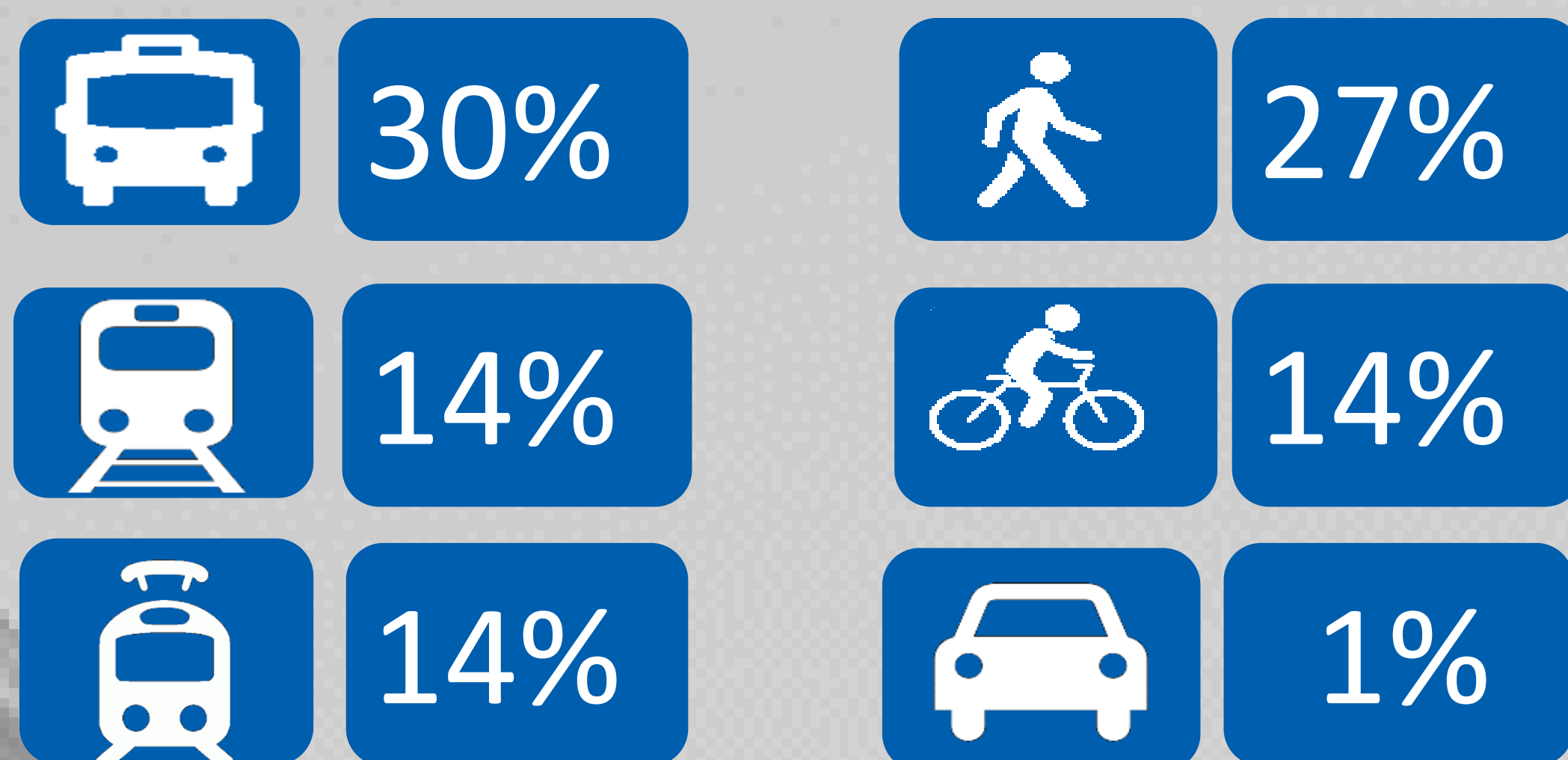

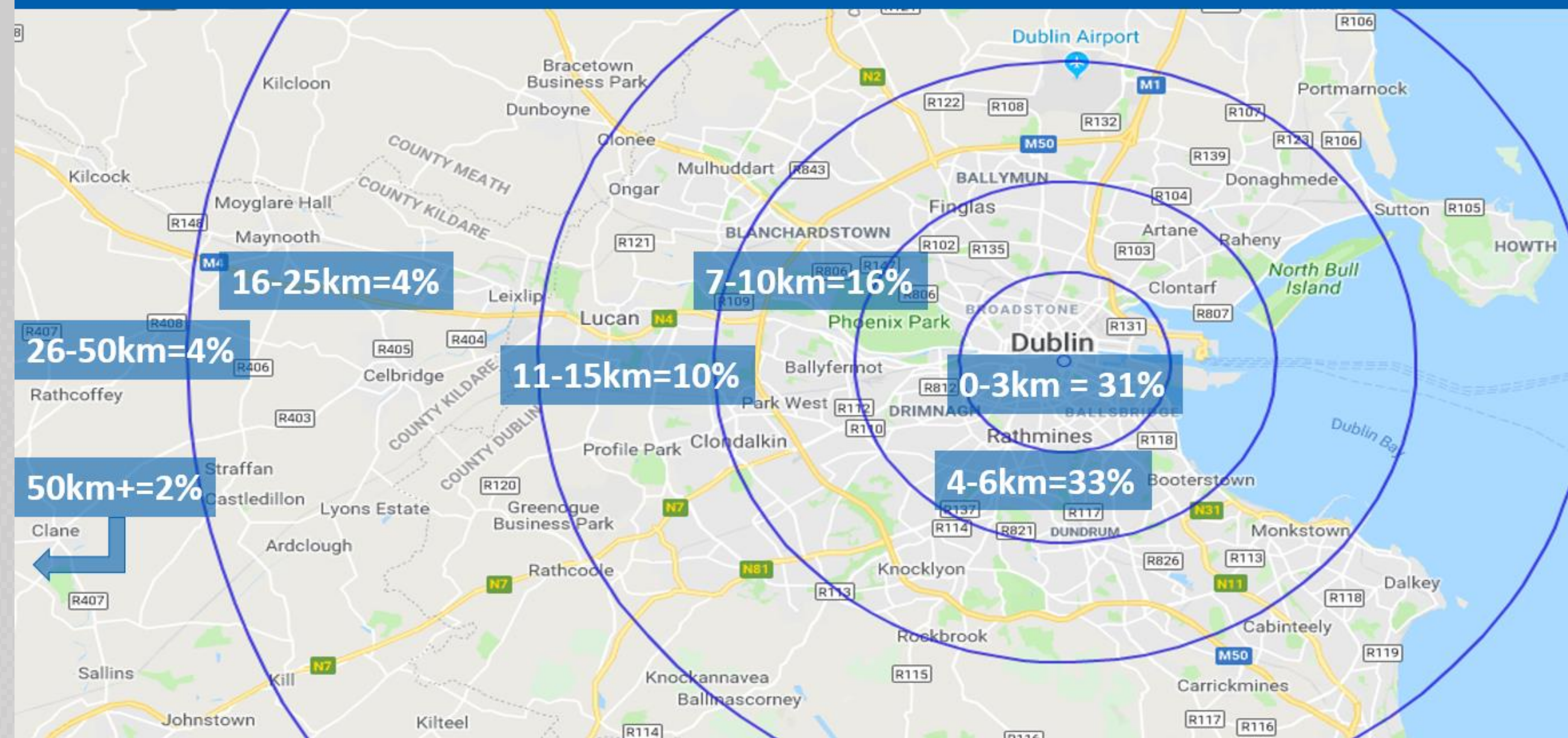

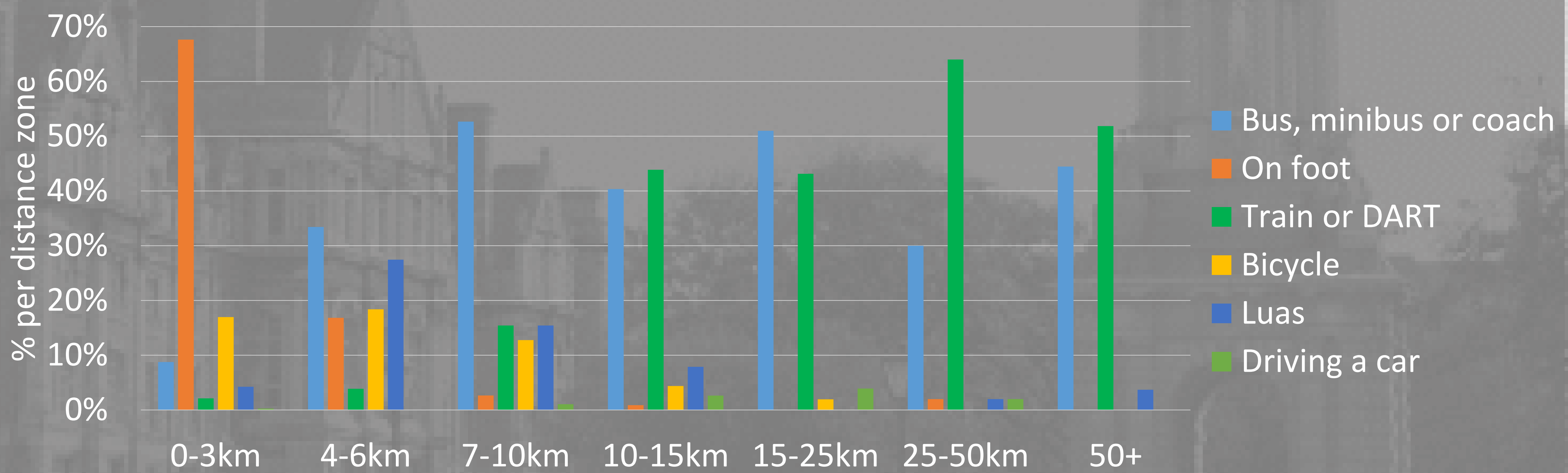
How do you Travel to Trinity?



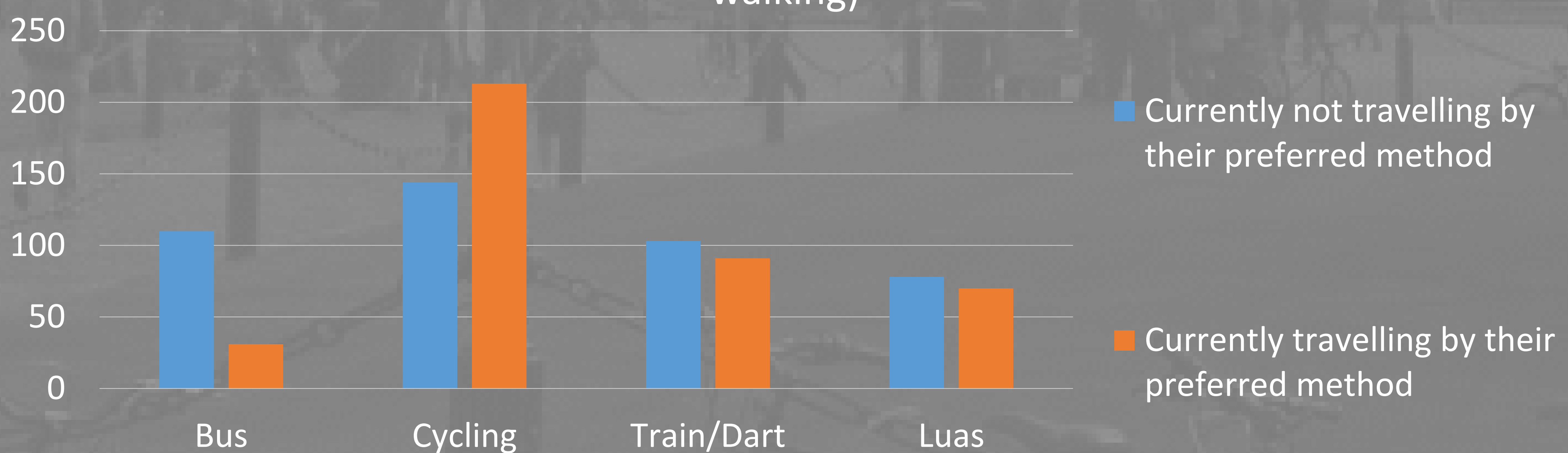
Approx. how far do you travel daily to Trinity? n=1,209



How does modal choice change as distances increase? n= 1,193



If the option was there, which mode would you choose? (Excluding walking)



- Anecdotal evidence that students are living at large distances from college due to housing was not supported by the data with the majority of students living within 6 km.
- Those living closest to College favour walking, those further out favour train or Dart, with the middle to long distances dominated by buses, which is broadly in line with expectations.
- The cycling group was the largest that was not travelling by their preferred method – indicating that this is the group most likely to change mode of transport if the option was available
