Description The module is designed to enable students to undertake directed research on a project of their choice, as an introduction to the kind of independent research, and the variety of primary sources and historical methods, they will encounter throughout their studies in History. Students will develop skills through working in groups, including setting objectives, assigning tasks, collating information and completing co-operative assignments. Generally there will be at discrete 'research streams' available in a given year. Each will focus on a broad area of history, allowing groups to develop their own projects across a range of types of history (cultural, social, political, etc.) as well as relating diverse times and places.
