## Honorary Professor

The procedures governing the appointment of Honorary Professors are already provided for in Section 2 of Schedule 1 on Titles to the Chapter on Academic Staff in the 2010 Statutes.

Honorary Professors are appointed by the Board on the nomination of the University Council. It is a title that the university may give to an especially distinguished academic to associate him or her with the College. An Honorary Professor is not normally a salaried employee of the College.

a) Criteria for appointment:

An Honorary Professor should be an especially distinguished academic. He or she should be in a position to enhance the work of the nominating Faculty.

b) Nomination and appointment procedures:

Applications for Honorary Professorships are made to the Senior Promotions Committee. The appointment is made by the University Council on foot of a nomination received from the Senior Promotions Committee.

c) The role and responsibilities of Honorary Professors, such as they are, will be specified by the Faculty Dean.

d) The term of appointment may be up to five years, renewable. Renewal is not automatic and is contingent upon the agreement of the Faculty Dean.
