This factsheet explains how to access healthcare as an international student living in Belfast.

In an Emergency

The Accident and Emergency unit is at the Royal Victoria Hospital, Falls Road, West Belfast. In case of emergency call 999 (ambulance, fire service and police).

Accessing Healthcare

EU citizens and students on a Tier 4 visa are entitled to healthcare through the National Health Service. You can sign up with any GP practice in your area and it should be a simple process. We recommend that you do this at an early stage when you are setting up home in Belfast. Make an appointment to register and bring along your ID documentation.
