Biography: Prof. Serge-Thomas Bonino, Pontifical University of Saint Thomas Aquinas, Rome

Br Serge-Thomas Bonino, o.p. was born in Marseille in 1961. He entered the Dominicans in 1982 and was ordained (Priest) in 1988. An alumnus of the l'Ecote Normale supérieure, a doctor in both philosophy and theology, he has studies in Paris, Toulouse and Fribourg. He is a master in sacred theology. Having been director of the Revue thomiste in Toulouse, he is in Rome since 2014. He was secretary general of the International Theological Commission from 2011 to 2020. He is currently a consultor to the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, president of the Pontifical Academy of St Thomas Aquinas and Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy at the Pontifical University of St Thomas Aquinas (Anglican), where he teaches dogmatic theology, and [the history of medieval teachings]. Among his recent publication are *Dieu, 'Celui qui est' (De Deo ut uno)* (2016), *Les anges et les démons* (deuxième édition, 2017; *Angels and Demons. A Catholic Introduction*, Translated by Michael Miller, Washington D.C., 2016), *Etudes thomasiennes* (2018), *Saint Thomas, lecteur du Cantique des cantiques* (2019).
