• Empowering healthcare leaders to develop an entrepreneurial and innovative approach to problem solving within the healthcare system

• Enabling medical consultants and professionals to develop norms around team interactions and help them understand the part they play in high performing team development in the healthcare sector

• Integrating professional coaching to enable medical consultants and professionals to develop their resilience, unpack and explore their professional development and self-awareness.

The course comprises three four-day modules, two of which are residential to accelerate group cohesion.


