

MSc Student Consulting Project

Would your company benefit from having access to a team of highly motivated and innovative MSc students to help address a business challenge you have?

Our focus in Trinity Business School is to bring in-class learning to life with our strong emphasis on experiential learning and teamwork. The 'Student Consulting Project' is a capstone research project that achieves both objectives for our graduates and gives our partner organisations access to talent and workable solutions on a real business issue.

For the academic year 2023/24, these projects are assigned to our students from MSc in International Management & our MSc in Management. These students all have a primary degree and many have an additional European language. Each have shown both ambition and high academic credentials in their application.

Why should you participate?

- 1. Our students offer a fresh next-generation perspective on problems and our academic mentors ensure that the recommendations they develop are of high-quality and useful to your business.
- 2. Working with our students is a great way of establishing, maintaining and strengthening the relationship between your company and Trinity Business School as well as its faculty members.
- 3. Recruit talent directly from the school.



How does it work?

Delivered over 8 weeks. you will engage with a consulting team of 5 students from either MSc in Management or MSc in International Management. They will analyse your organisation's business opportunity and produce a complete actionable report that will include a range of solutions and implementation plan. In addition to the final report, the student consulting team will deliver its findings via a succinct presentation.

- Identify business challenge or opportunity. Submit ideas to Trinity Business School. Discuss & finalise project scope with module leader.
- 2. Trinity allocate student consulting teams to partner companies. Trinity Business School mentors are also assigned to support student teams & participating company.
- 3. Students collaborate with host company to analyse challenge, evaluate alternatives and develop actionable plan, connecting with the company at various intervals throughout the project.
- 4. Student consulting team create written report and presentation for final feedback from the company.
