# GEC/23-24/June.3 Planning for Global Engagement beyond GRS3

VP Global noted the Spring 2025 timeline for the final documentation of the next Trinity Global Business Plan. She highlighted the following points for consideration under this plan: reasons for Trinity to go global, our future expectations and aspirations.

She highlighted the need to develop concept notes for discussion and called for expressions of interest from the Global Directors to engage in this activity.

# GEC/23-24/June.4 Evaluation of the committee

VP Global highlighted the need to consider the best purpose for the Global Engagement Committee aligned to the college governance structures.

It was noted that Trinity Global engages with the college community in multiple ways outside of the Global Engagement Committee, which might provide an opportunity to review the membership of the GEC.

The opportunity to review the role of the Global Director was also highlighted. It was suggested that this role may include common sets for responsibilities for all Global Directors and additional responsibilities specific to schools pertaining to the schools plans and strategies.

The opportunity to review the TOR of GEC was also raised.
