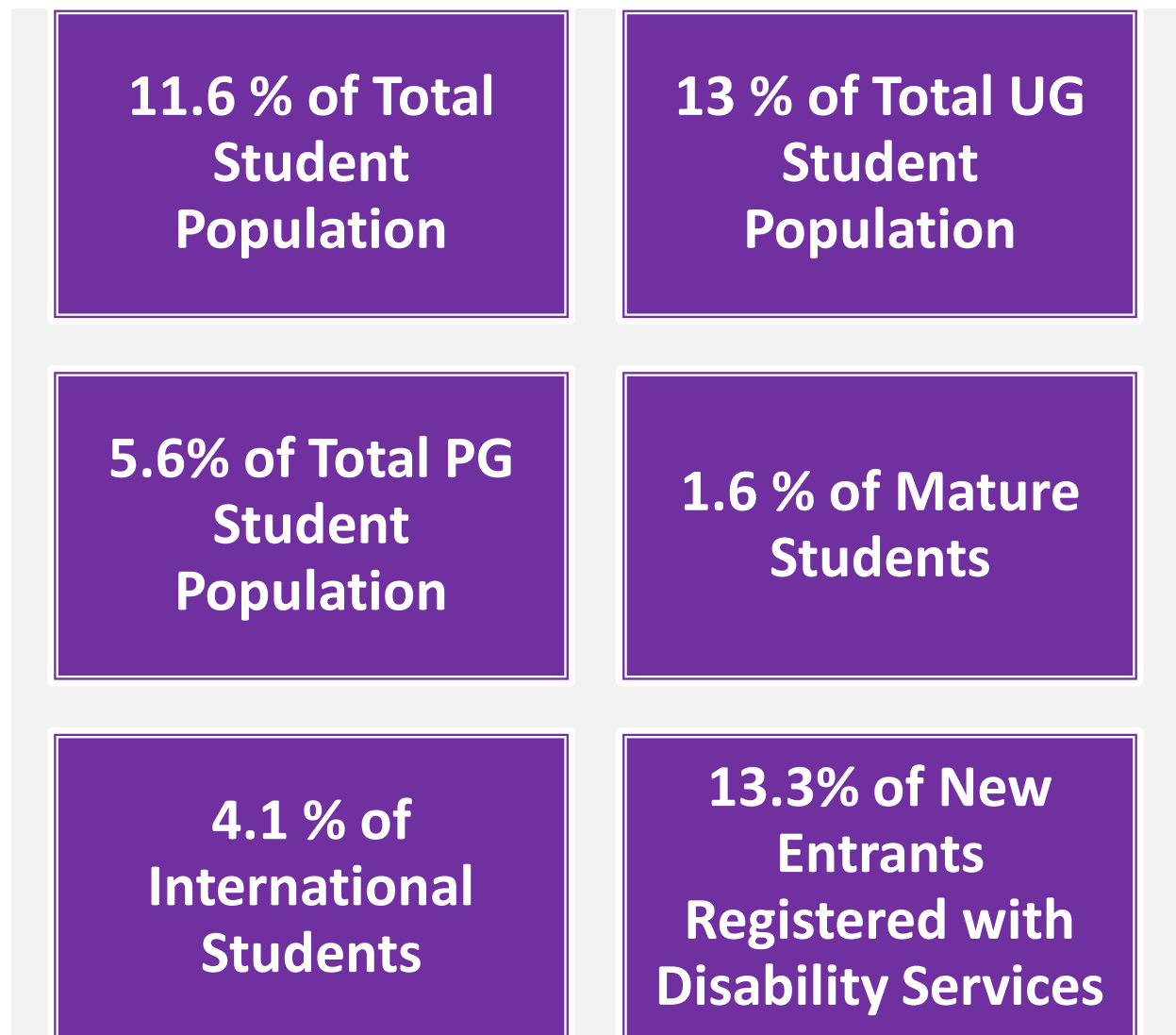

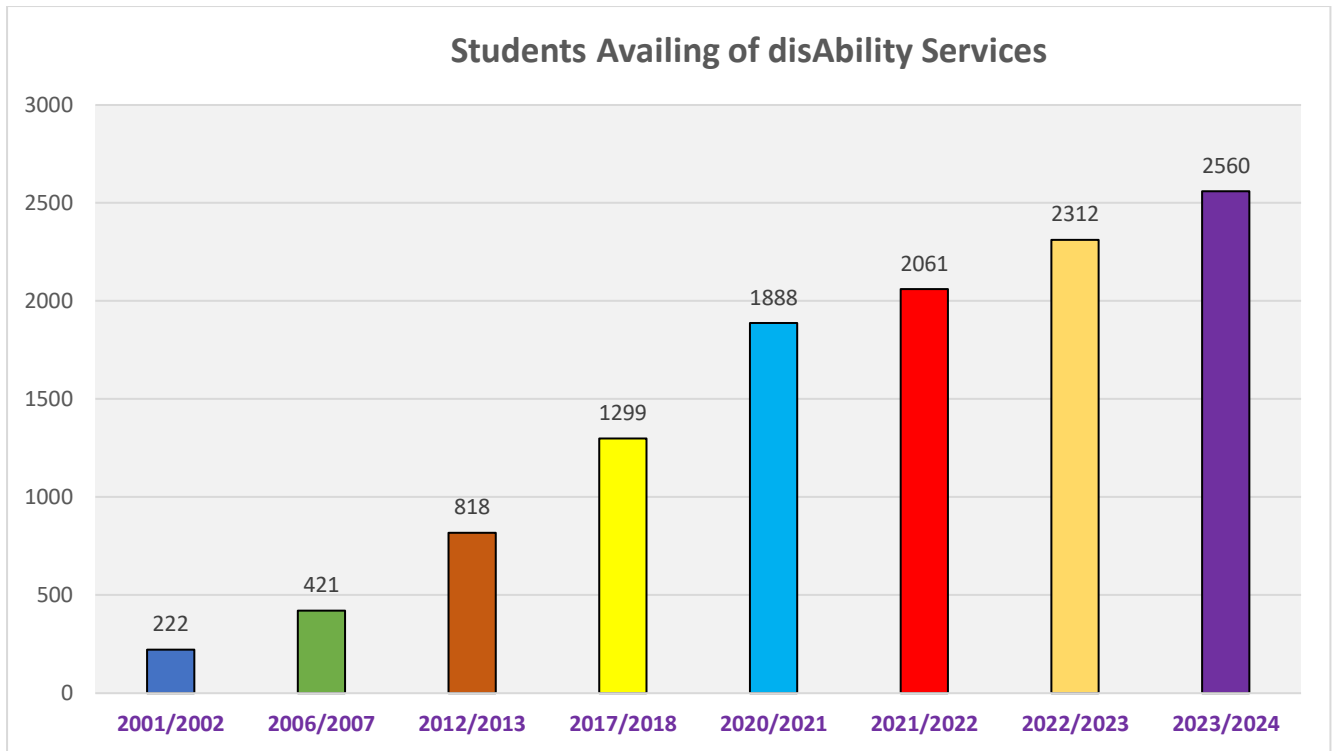

## Growth of Service:

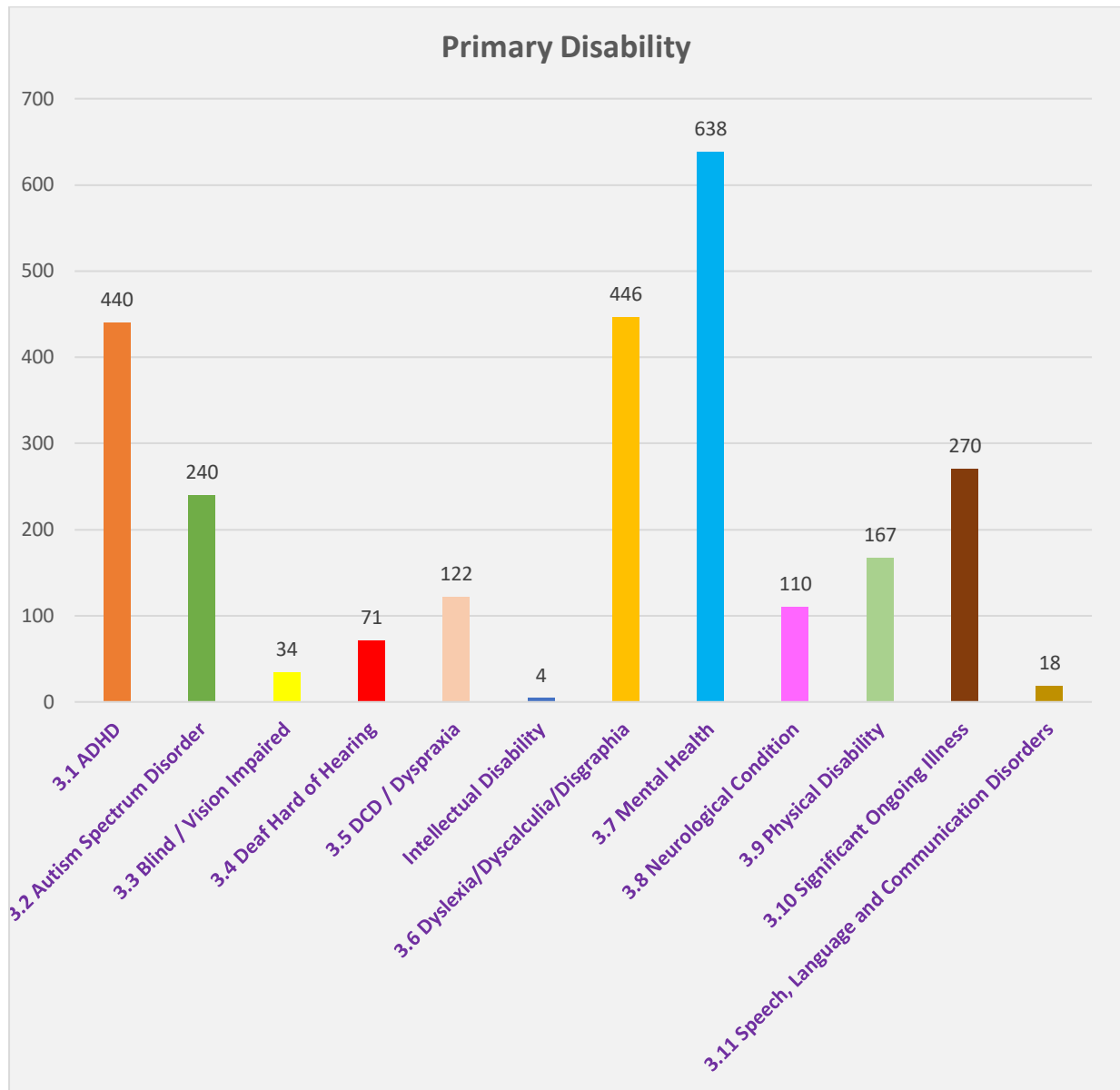
The number of students applying for Disability Supports has increased significantly, from 222 in 2001/2002 to 2560 in 2023/2024.



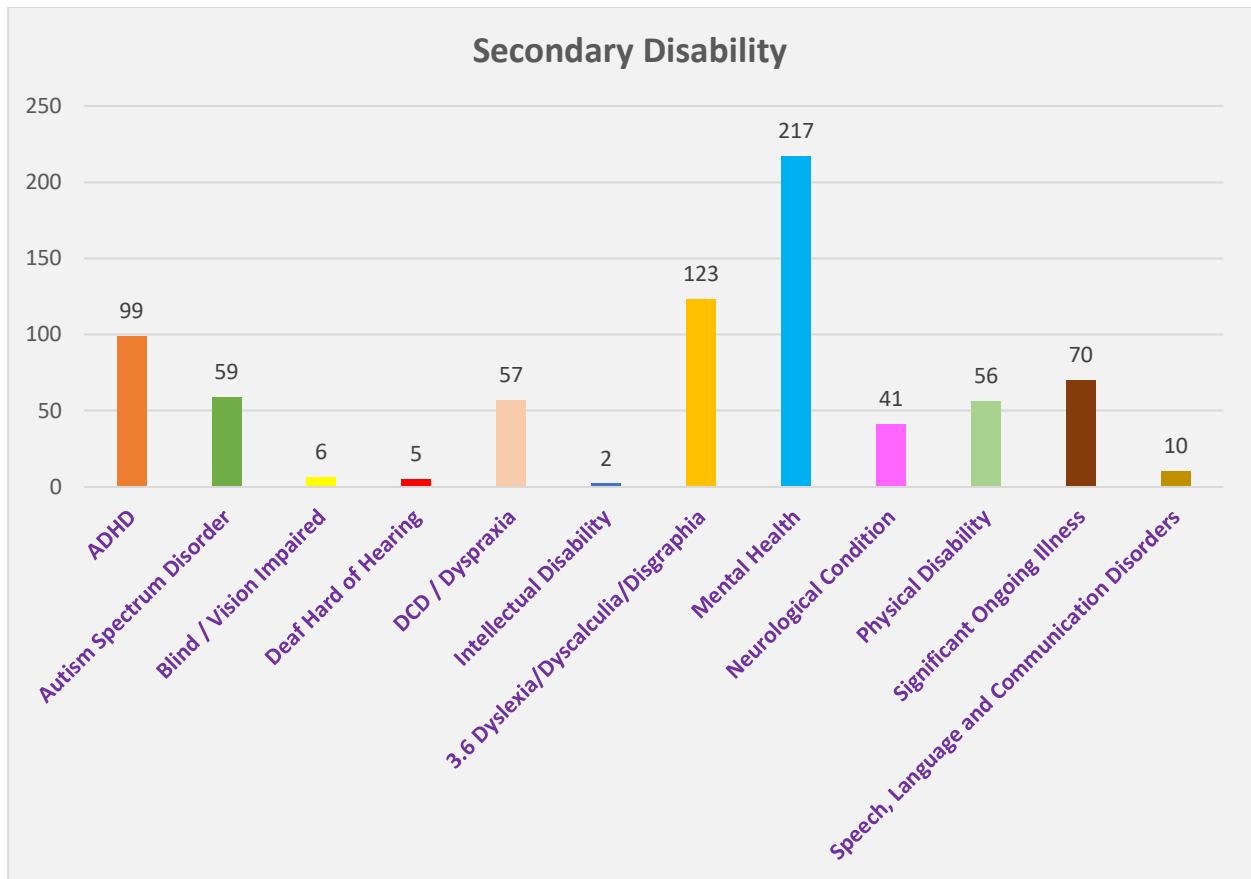

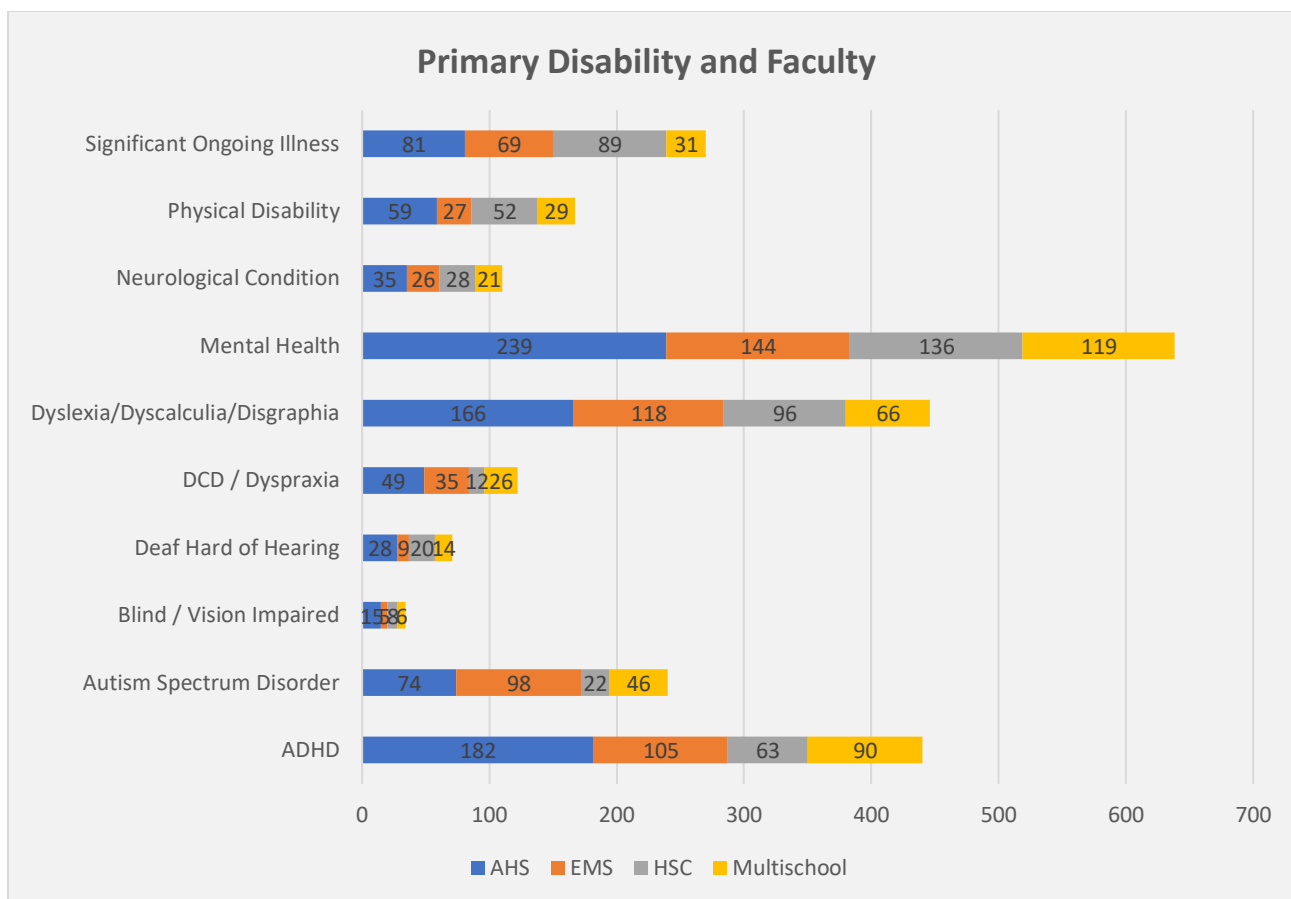
