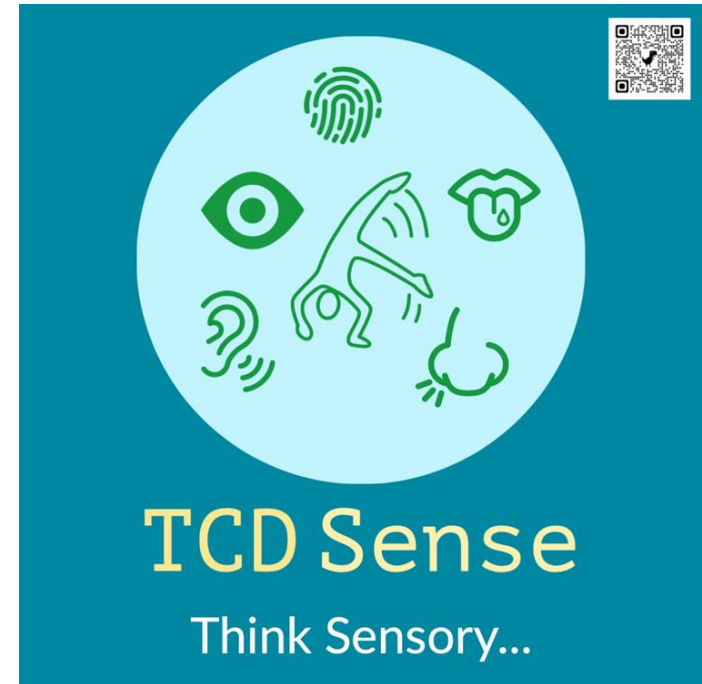

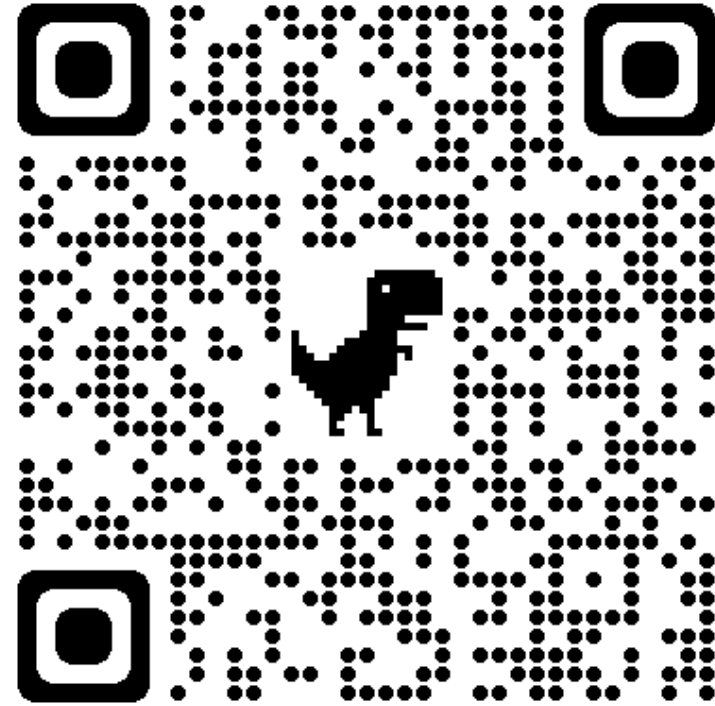

We are all sensory beings, and although we may not always be fully aware of it, sensation is everywhere.

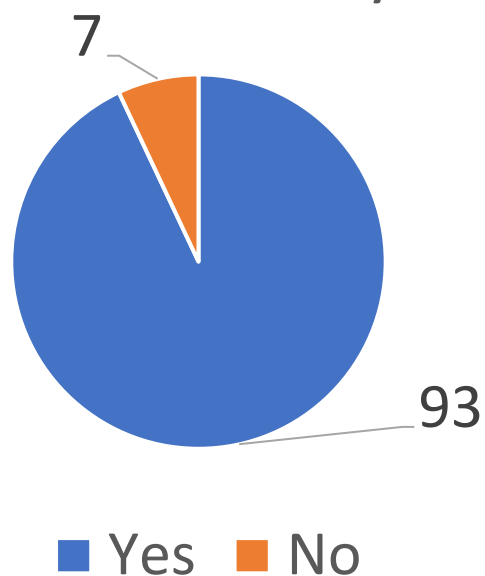

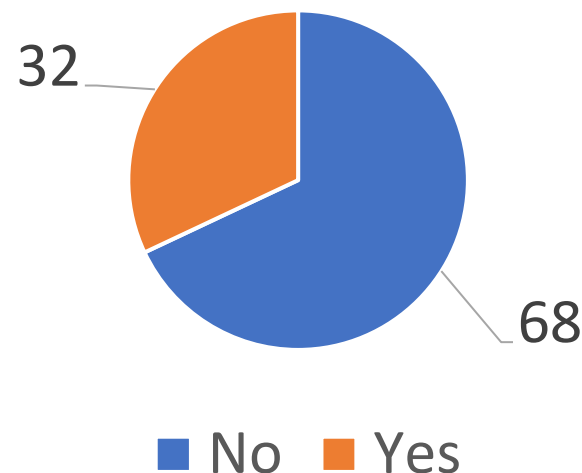


Project Background - Trinity Context

in the Library



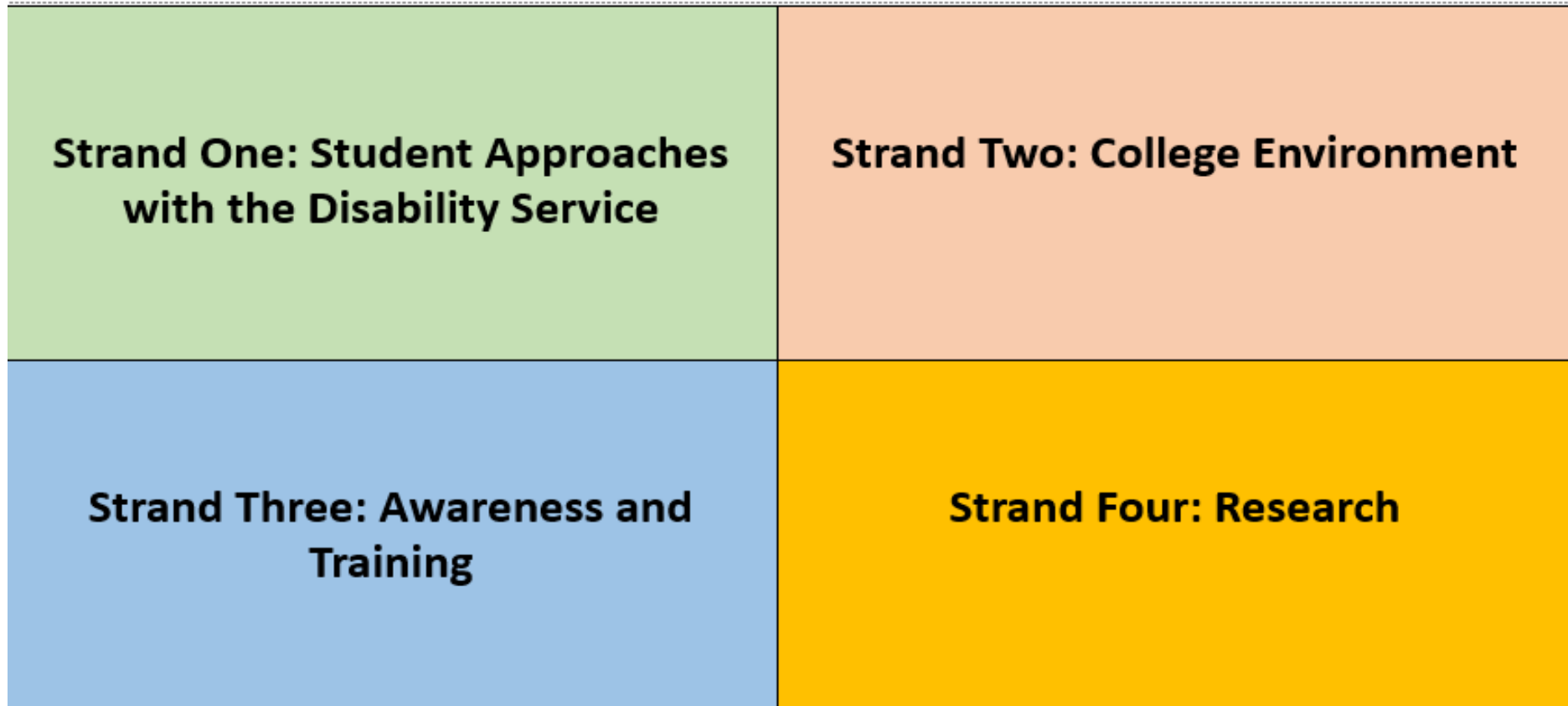
Quiet space on campus that
