

## **Constantia Maxwell Faculty Studentship 2026/27**

New students on the PME register may apply to be considered for the Constantia Maxwell Faculty Studentship for the academic year 2026-27. The studentship is worth €3,000 and is awarded through a contribution towards tuition fees (EU or Non-EU) for one year of the programme. The studentship is funded by the Trinity's Faculty of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences.

### **Eligibility**

This studentship is available to NEW entrants (EU and Non-EU) to the PME programme for first admission to either programme in September 2026. Continuing students are not eligible to apply. To be eligible to apply, applicants must hold and have officially accepted an Unconditional Offer of a place on one of these programmes by May 15<sup>th</sup> 2026.

### **Selection Criteria**

Criteria for evaluating applications for the studentships include: demonstrated academic merit of the candidate; relevant work experience; relevant voluntary experience; potential within the field of education; demonstrated need for financial assistance; membership of historically marginalised groups. Applications will be reviewed by the School of Education Scholarship Committee and decisions are final.

### **Conditions**

The studentship is offered subject to the following conditions:

1. The awardee must engage in full-time or part-time study and must register for the PME in the academic year 2026/27;
2. The studentship cannot be held in addition to other College scholarship awards;
3. Failure to register for the relevant programme for September 2026 will result in the studentship being allocated to the next highest ranked applicant.

### **How to apply?**

Applicants who meet the above criteria and wish to be considered for this studentship must submit **a CV and a Cover Letter** (max 750 words) no later than May 15<sup>th</sup> 2026.

The CV should include the following information:

1. Full name and Trinity application number (assigned when an application is submitted to Trinity);
2. Name of the course and strand for which you intend to register;
3. Details of undergraduate or postgraduate courses completed or in progress, including awarding institutions, final marks/award levels or current standings;
4. Details of additional awards or qualifications (certificates, badges etc.);
5. Details of previous scholarships held;
6. Details of work experience relevant to your proposed course of study;
7. Details of voluntary experience relevant to your proposed course of study.

The Cover Letter should describe, in no more than 750 words why you believe you are deserving of the studentship.

### Submission process

Applications which do not adhere to the required format will not be considered. Please submit your application as follows:

- The personal statement should not exceed 750 words in total;
- Submit the CV and Cover Letter as a single Microsoft Word or PDF document, attached to your submission email;
