## **MUSIC TECHNOLOGY: Serverproject**

From 2003 to 2007 I was a member of Serverproject (see above). I developed a bespoke hybrid hardware/software system consisting of four networked max/msp patches and a custom interface for the group to perform with. The hardware was manufactured to my specification by Owen Drumm Designs.

### **MUSIC TECHNOLOGY: Between Machines**

Between Machines began with the development of DAXA, a software/hardware hybrid that extends the capabilities of the classic Yamaha DX7 synthesiser. DAXA is still under development in collaboration with improvisor David Donohoe. I am currently developing other electronic musical devices and systems under the umbrella Between Machines. The current focus is QLOCKER, a stochastic rhythm generator module for the Eurorack modular format.
