## **Module Content**

This module introduces students to the study of German literature as an end in itself, as a means of gaining cultural knowledge of the German-speaking lands, and as a resource for improving linguistic competence. Students will read a rich and varied selection of German-language literary texts.<sup>1</sup>

### **Aims**

This module aims to develop reading skills in a range of literary text types; to introduce students to the terms and concepts of literary criticism; to build up general and specialist vocabulary.

# **Learning Outcomes**

On successful completion of this module, students should be able to:

- 1. read literary texts independently and comfortably in German<sup>2</sup>
- 2. offer nuanced and alert critical responses to German literary texts
- 3. demonstrate understanding of a range of -critical and theoretical approaches to the study of literature
- 4. use literary texts as a source of linguistic and cultural knowledge
- 5. identify key characteristics of different literary genres
- 6. write critical essays in which primary and secondary material is handled correctly
