This team-taught module starts with an historical examination of the societies and regions of the Middle East. This is followed by a critical assessment of the representations of the Middle East in European culture as well as the way in which Europe has been viewed in parts of the Middle East. Debates about the construction of Middle Eastern identities and cultures are explored as well as from both historical and contemporary perspectives.

- Identify the different historical experiences of the diverse population groups of the Middle East
- Identify sources and trends for the representation of the Middle East in both Europe and the Middle East
