- express the following meanings: quantity (how many?), time (when? how long?), location + direction (where?), means (how?), cause (why? how come?), purpose (to what end?), frequency (how often?)
- comprehend and extract main points from Polish-language texts, correctly identify the general idea of a text, locate specifically required information, summarise
- comprehend contextual information (people, places and events) in Polish-language texts
- use reference tools (dictionaries and grammars) to obtain grammatical and lexical information
- formulate questions about structures they do not understand
- write short texts in Polish language
- use Polish to express information about themselves and others, tell a story, express an opinion
