Important Information

- Participants must be 18 years of age or older to enrol in the School of Languages, Literatures and Cultural Studies evening courses.
- Fees are non-refundable once a course has commenced.
- For post-beginner language levels achieved prior to taking Trinity evening courses, permission must be first confirmed by the instructor and the School's Short Courses Administrator.
- All courses are offered subject to minimum and maximum registration numbers. In the event of a full course cancellation due to an insufficient number of applicants or another reason, fees will be refunded in full.
- Participation in an evening course does not allow for access to Trinity Library or any other student services.
- **You are not formally registered in any course until you have completed payment for the course in full, have completed and submitted the application form on time once received, and have received written confirmation of your active registration from the Administrator for evening courses in the School of Languages, Literatures and Cultural Studies.**
