did not attend third level previously

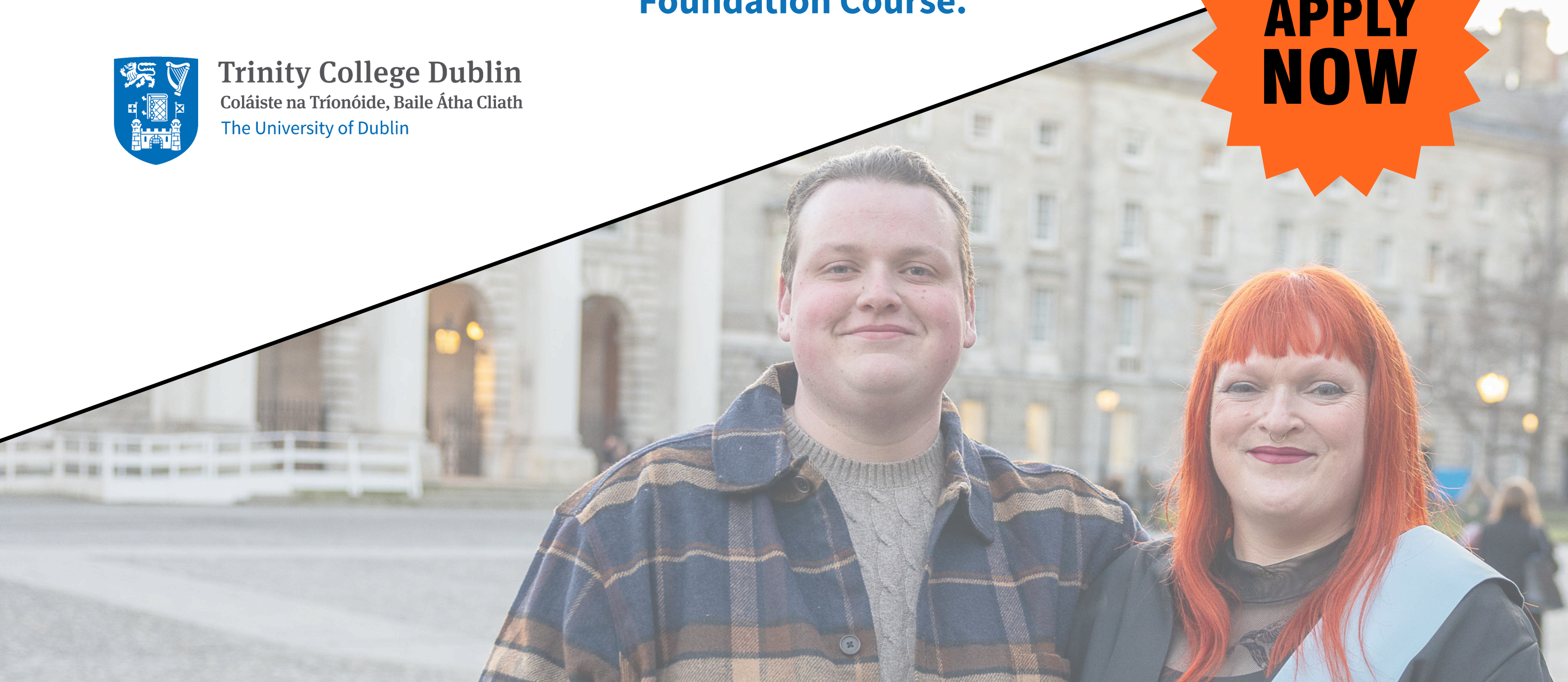


are **eligible for free university fees**
