The RKD Registry and Biobank continues to support vital research projects toward better understanding of the complex auto-immune condition, ANCA Vasculitis.

In this, our 10th year of existence, we have surpassed 900 vasculitis patient recruits, banked over 40,000 sample aliquots, and, using these samples and their corresponding clinical datasets, have supported over 50 research studies to date.


During the last year, over 800 patient samples, with clinical data, were supplied to approved research studies investigating ANCA vasculitis. 


