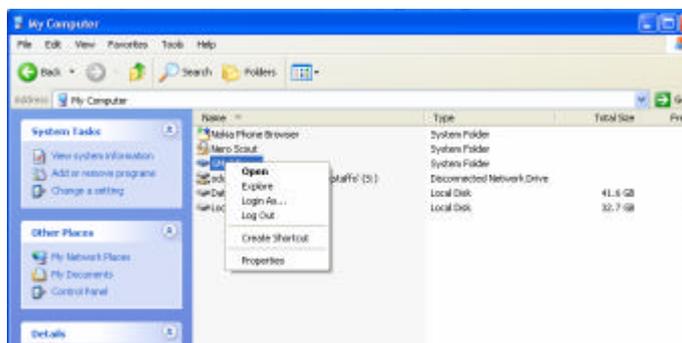


## Using GmailFS to back up your data

- Set up your Gmail account
- Install GmailFS
- A new drive appears on your computer, like this:



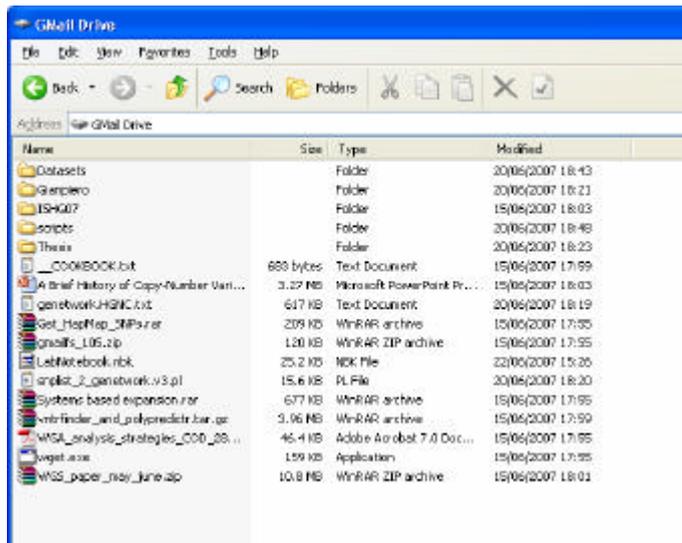
- Edit the properties accordingly ("Login as" option):



- Edit the "More" settings for when you want to access Gmail from TCD. Also, set it up to "Auto Login":



- What things look like when you click into the Gmail drive. Files show have been just dragged and dropped over from "My Documents" in this case:



**Notes:**

- If your file is too big, zip it. If it's still too big, use something like WinRAR to "Split to volumes". You can also do this using the UNIX/Cygwin "split" command.
- If you change your college password, remember to change the "Login as" settings for the Gmail drive.
